(i) A person of high moral values as acknowledged by Allah:-

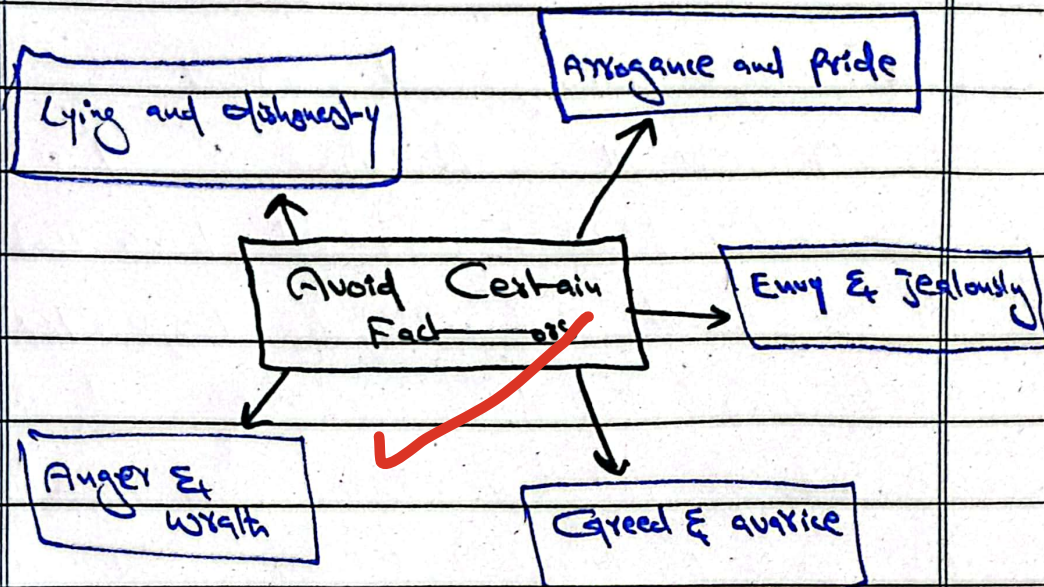
