Noble morals of Holy Prophet (ﷺ) with his relatives

Holy Prophet (ﷺ) took the responsibility of his cousin Hazrat Ali (رضي الله عنه). Holy Prophet (ﷺ) was in gijra when Hazrat Hamza was martyred. This shows the care that Holy Prophet (ﷺ) used to do for his relatives.

Noble morals of Holy Prophet (ﷺ) with slaves
