of inflation. Thus, the excess

of exports, revenue deficit and

higher taxes in Pakistan

are not cause of economic

crisis and inflation.

(Water Crisis and Agriculture)  
try to be more well connected

The major decline in agriculture sector of Pakistan is due to water crisis. Scarcity of water in agriculture has affected the contribution of agriculture sector in GDP of the country which is 34 percent.

The decline in availability of water which was 800 cubic meter in 1950 it is 1000 cubic meter today. Further, out dated irrigation system approximately 90 percent of water used for agriculture is wasted due to out dated irrigation systems.

This is how scarcity of water is increased due to lack of advancement in water management for agriculture like drip irrigation system. The declined water level and out dated irrigation systems has increased the problems of agriculture.
