Introduction

The concept of Prophethood, cornerstone of Islam, encapsulates the divine appointment of chosen individuals to convey Good. His guidance to mankind. From Prophet Adam to Prophet Muhammad (PBUH), all of them try to guide humanity towards right path. Therefore, this concept holds immense importance by providing moral, spiritual and social guidance. Thus, it is a source of inspiration and guidance for all mankind during complexities of life.

Concept of Prophethood

Literal Meaning:

the term "Prophethood" comes from the root word prophet which refers to someone who tells news or information.

Contextual Meaning:

in the context of Islamic doctrine, it means the institution through which God sends His guidance to humanity.

Definitions of Prophethood:

⇒ Prophethood is the Divine choice ^{selection} of an individual to whom divine teachings are revealed in order to guide people to the path of perfection and happiness.

Concept of Prophethood in Islam

a) Belief in all Prophets:

It is the vital concept of Islamic doctrine. A believer must have to believe in all prophets in Islamic faith. As all prophets preach divine guidance, guiding humanity towards righteousness. Therefore, it is a crucial aspect of fundamentals of Islam.

- ﴿لَا يُنَزِّلُ لِكُلِّ قَوْمٍ بِّرْهَانٌ﴾

"We make no distinction between any of them".

(Al-Insan: 85)

b. Finality of Prophethood:

Finality of Prophethood refers to the seal of prophets as Holy Prophet (PBUH) declared: *لَيْسَ بَعْدِي إِلَّا خَاتَمُ النَّبِيِّنَ*

It represents completeness and universality of Divine messages. Thus, it fosters a sense of unity in society as all people have received uniform message.

c) Infallibility of Prophets

It is a vital component of Islamic faith which encapsulates that all messengers and prophets are infallible. Furthermore, however, human beings commit mistakes while prophets are pure and clean.

إِنَّمَا وُجُوهُنَّ مُّبَكِّرَةٍ - وَمَا يَبْطِئُنَّ أَهْوَاهُنَّ

It is only a revelation sent down "to him". And he does not speak of his own whims.

(An-Najm: 3-4)

a) Divine Guidance is derived from Revelation

Holy Quran is an ultimate source of guidance.

Therefore, all Muslims seek guidance and wisdom from the scriptures of Allah Almighty such as Gospel, Psalms, Torah and Holy Quran. However, the eternal and perfect source of guidance is Holy Quran.

- ﴿وَلَمَّا جَاءَنَا رَجُلٌ مِّنْ أَنْفُسِهِمْ

e) Prophets As Role Models and Exemplars

The ultimate objective of Islam is to make a man morally virtuous. To him, the exemplars of virtue are prophets and messengers. Thus, in order to seek guidance, it is vital to learn from prophets. Moreover, they exemplify compassion, integrity and virtue.

- ﴿إِنَّمَا يُنَزَّلُ مِنْ رَبِّكَ لِتَذَكَّرَ

"There was indeed the best model for you in the Messenger of Allah" (Al Ahzab: 21)

f) Mission of Prophets for Monotheism

The mission of Prophets is to preach teachings of Islam, reinforcing the concept of tawheed. Therefore, all of the prophets underscored the belief in tawhid: a belief in the unity of Allah.

اَنْنِي اَنَا اللَّهُ لَا اَلَّهَ اِلَّا اَنَا^{حَمَدُونَ}

Indeed, I am Allah. There is no deity except me so worshipp me.
(Al-Qur'an)

Importance of Concept of Prophethood

Give individual and collective life importance

a). Ethical Guidance and Role Models:

The belief in prophethood encapsulates that divine wisdom and guidance is provided by prophets to humanity. Moreover, they acted as a perfect guide to humanity, capturing the essence of Islamic values.

Thus, the believers can attain true wisdom and guidance by following the footsteps of Prophets.

وَمَا أَرْسَلْنَا إِلَّا رُّشْدًا
We have sent "O Prophet" only as a mercy to all the world.

(Al Anbya: 107)

b). Divine Revelation for Spiritual Enlightenment:

The ultimate goal of prophethood is to enlighten hearts and minds of mankind. Therefore, the divine guidance acts as a means to transform an individual spiritually. Before the advent of Islam, people were living in ignorance. Allah has sent prophets and messengers to show humanity the right and virtuous path.

سُبْ - وَالْقُرْآنُ الْحَمْدُ
Ya Sin, by the Quran, rich in wisdom!

(Surah Yasin: 1-2)

c). Social Justice and Equality:

The belief in prophethood teaches lesson of social justice and equality. In the Treaty of Hudaibiyyah, the Holy Prophet

equity. Thus, all people are considered equal in people and before Allah. Moreover, in the society, all people are justified by law, which are equal compassion, integrity and justice. Indeed, Allah orders "إِنَّ اللَّهَ يُحِبُّ الْمُتَّقِينَ" (Surah An Nahl: 90) "Indeed, Allah orders justice and good conduct."

a) Solace, Satisfaction and Hope in Adversity:

(The belief in

Prophethood encapsulates peace, satisfaction and hope in adversity. The Holy Prophet serves as a true example who faced multiple difficulties during his life but always expressed hope and determination.

Indeed, Allah is with those who fix patiently and steadfast. (2: 143)

c) Firm Faith By Accepting Prophethood:

It is an important doctrine of Islamic teachings. Therefore, a believer's faith strengthens after accepting the finality of prophethood and concept of prophethood. Furthermore, it brings inner peace as a believer gets divine guidance from prophet and messengers. It reinforces his belief in Allah and His prophet's. *Sussi*
