In contrast to the welcoming and submissive attitude towards colonial English values, which were promoted by British rulers and adopted by the people of India and that, Sir Syed Ahmed Khan and his highly accomplished and enlightened son, Syed Mahmood, both tried to adopt a different approach as if they were equal in status and rank to the British. The incident of the Agra Darbar in 1867 was well known not only by Muslims but by the entire Indian nation. Sir Syed Ahmed Khan left this court because Indians were given menial jobs opposite to the English. At this court, Sir Syed was to be awarded a medal. Later on, Commissioner Williams of Meerut was asked to present this award to Sir Syed Ahmed Khan at Aligarh Railway Station.
