The 27th Amendment in Pakistan's

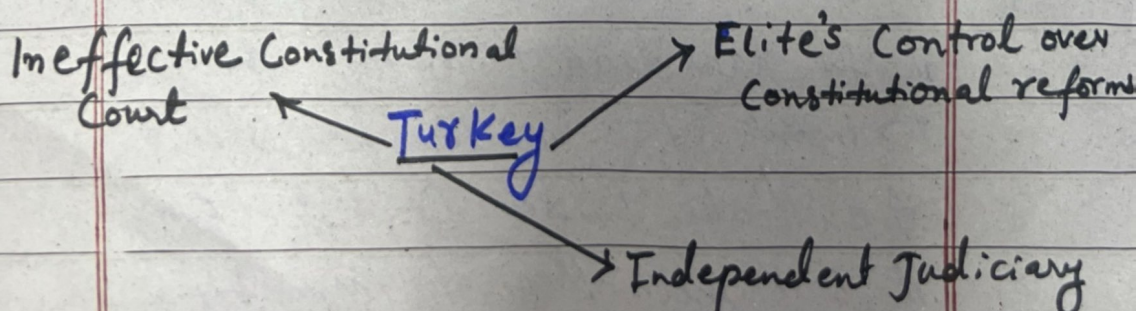
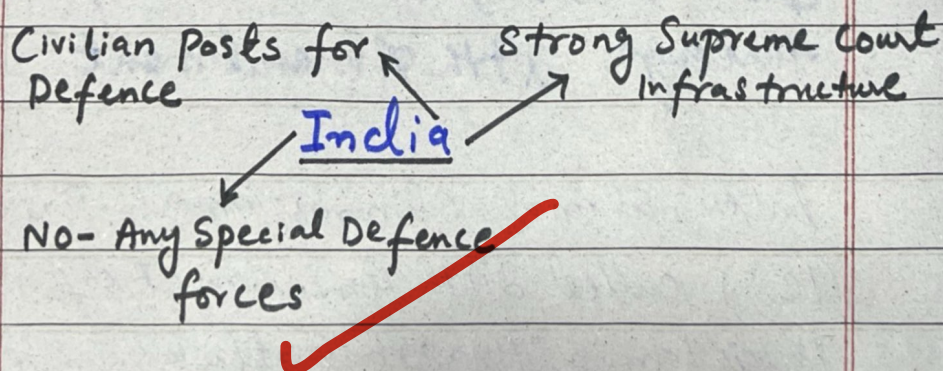
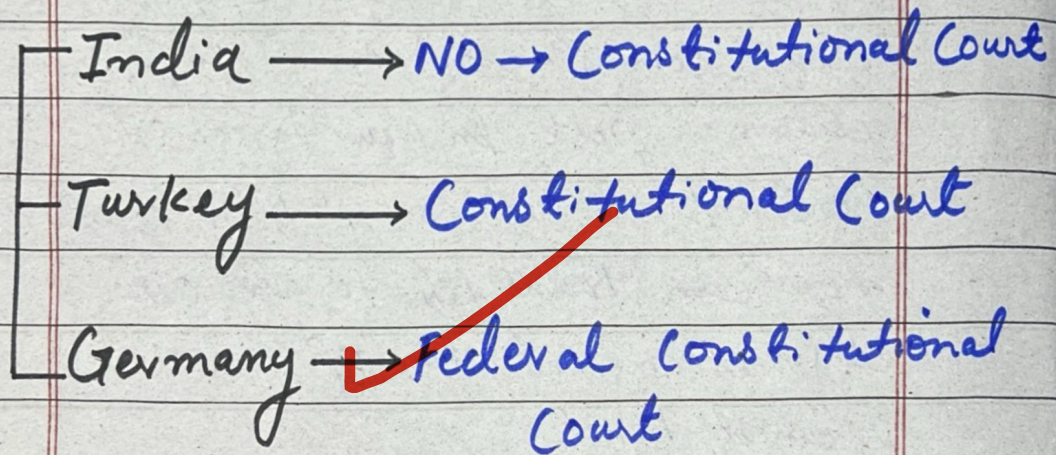

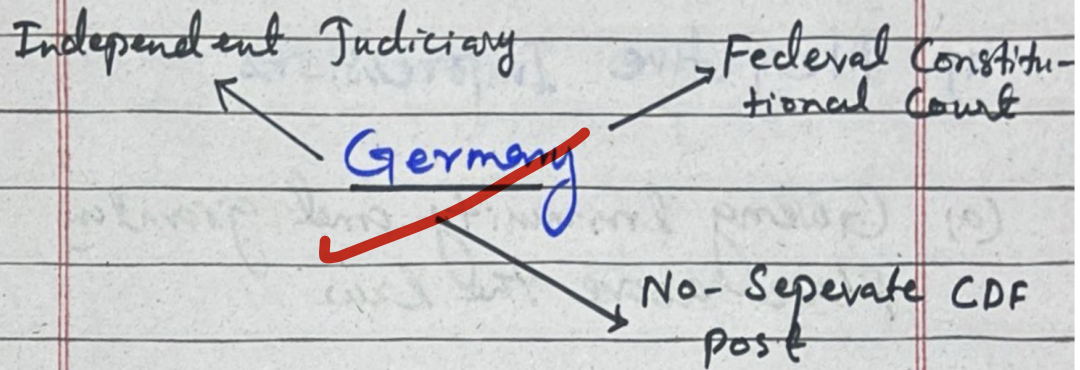
Sword on Judicial Independence through 27th Amendment

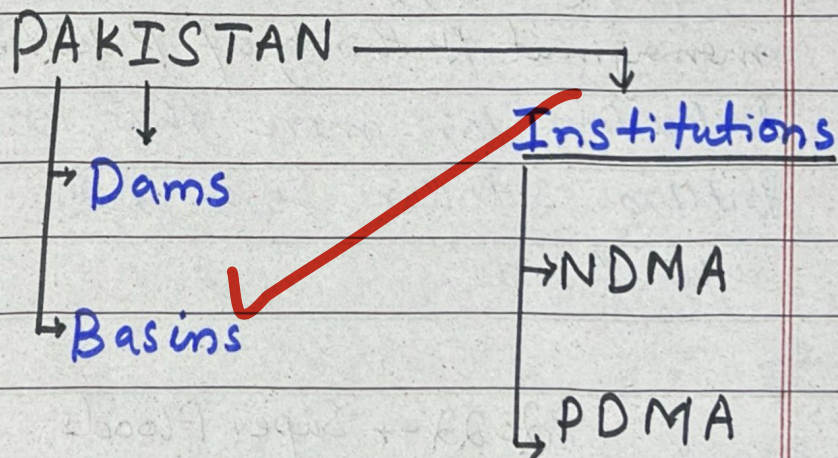
