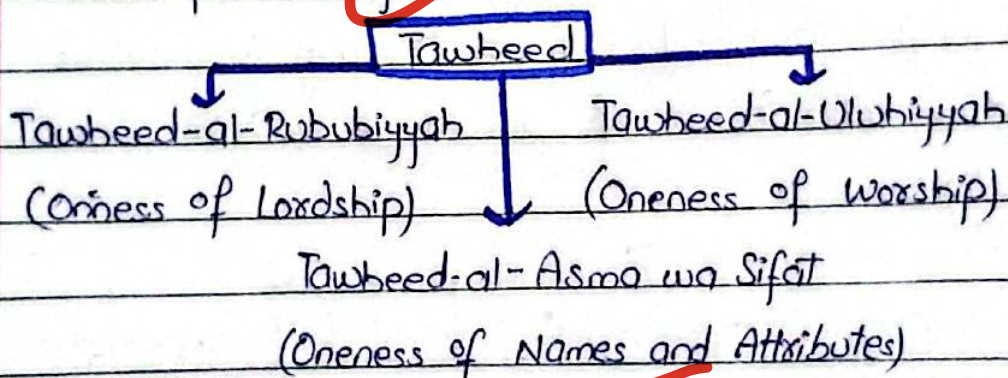


Question:

Exordium:

The word Tauheed (تَوْحِيد) is derived from the three consonants root w-h-d (و-ح-د), which serves as the basic and most fundamental concept in Islam. No one can enter into Islam without proclaiming that Allah is one.

Implications

Islam is a complete code of life. It provides practical guidance to Muslims in one way or the other. Some practical implications of concept of Tawheed are:

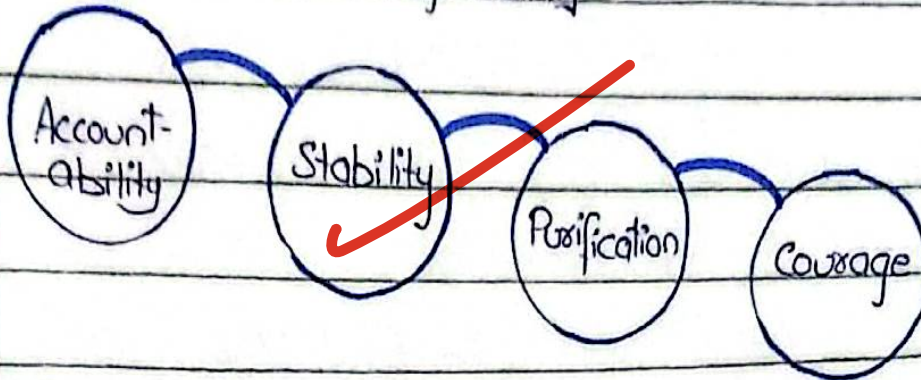
- a) Impact on Individual Character
- b) Impact on Social System
- c) Impact on Economic System
- d) Impact on Political System.

Through Tawheed, humans liberate themselves from all forms of servitude unlike other religions.

Impact on Individual Character

The concept of Tawheed is aligned with the inner soul of an individual. It improves individual's character in a way that he needs no one to rely on in any matter of life. When a person truly believes in this that Allah is one and All-Seeing- he continues to do

1) Moral Accountability:

Belief in All-Seeing God brings consciousness of monitoring each and every action when unsupervised.

★ The Quran says about moral accountability as:

وهو معكم أين ما كنتم
"He is with you wherever you are."

— Surah Hadid : 4

★ In accordance with Hadith:

"Have shame before Allah as you would before a righteous man from your family." — Tirmidhi.

2) Emotional Stability:

In the remembrance of Allah, there is peace, inner-satisfaction, happiness, and stability. If a person is truly devoted to Allah (s.w.t) he does not need external help or psychological dependence on created beings.

3) Purification of Intention:

Tawhid is aligned with the intentions of human being. All actions with pure intentions for Allah alone removes vanity, show-off, fame-seeking and ~~hypocrisy~~ from character of a person.

The Quran says:

حَسْبُنَا اللَّهُ وَنِعْمَ الْوَكِيلُ

"Sufficient for us is God and excellent is the disposer of affairs."

- Surah Al'Imran: 173

4) High Personal Courage:

Muslims are those nation of the world who often seemed as courageous, brave, self-sufficient in battles, and disciplined persons.

The sole ~~reason~~ of such confidence is the firm belief on Oneness of Allah.

The Quran stated that:

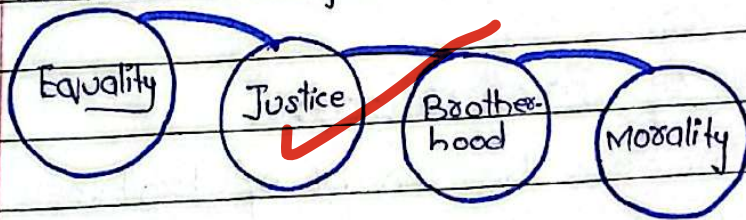
فاستقم كما امرت ومن تاب منك

Impact on Social System

The social system presented by Islam as a monotheist religion is remarkable.



1) Equality of All Human Beings:

Islam teaches us equality through Oneness of God. We all are created by One Allah and does not have any second or third class for representation.

The Quran says:

ان اكرمكم عند الله متكبر اتقوا

"Indeed, the most notable of you in the sight of Allah is the most righteous of you."

- Al-Hujurat: 93

2) Social Justice:

Belief in one God obligates fairness, honesty, and compassion in all dealings. Tawheed establishes a society where exploitation, oppression, and injustice are religiously forbidden.

يَا أَيُّهَا الَّذِينَ آمَنُوا كُونُوا قَوِّمِينَ بِالْقِسْطِ شُهَدَاءَ
لِلَّهِ وَلَوْ عَلَىٰ أَنْفُسِكُمْ

"O you who have believed, be persistently standing firm in justice, witness for Allah, even if it be against yourselves."

• Surah Nisa : 135

3) Promotion of Brotherhood:

Tawheed promotes the concept of brotherhood through this ayah as well:

إِنَّمَا الْمُؤْمِنُونَ إِخْوَةٌ

"The believers are but brothers."

- Surah Hujurat : 10

4) Collective Moral Responsibility:

Tawheed creates a society where moral values are rooted in worship of Allah - not human desires. Tawheed promotes *amr bil maruf* and *nahy anil munkar*.

وَيُأْمُرُونَ بِالْمَعْرُوفِ وَيَنْهَوْنَ عَنِ الْمُنْكَرِ

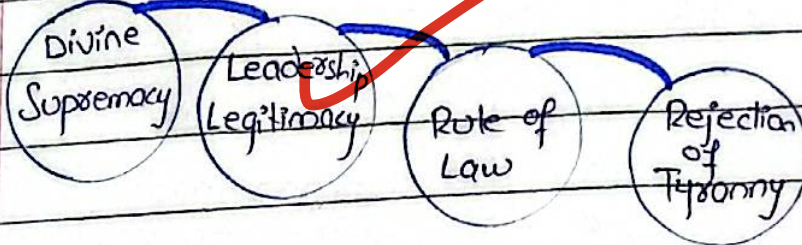
"Enjoining what is right and forbidding

Impact on Political System

The political implications of Tawheed trace back its roots to the Riasat-e-Madina. The crescendo example of political system based on Tawheed.



1) Supremacy of Divine Sovereignty:

Tawheed establishes that ultimate sovereignty belongs to Allah not to any king, elites, or majorities.

ان الحكم الا لله

"The command belongs to none but Allah."

- Surah Yusuf: 40

2) Legitimate Leadership

Tawheed makes a ruler answerable to Allah, not merely to citizens or tribes. This concept produces governance based on Adl, transparency,

3) Rejection of Tyranny:

Tawheed negates all forms of Taghut (false
authority) ensuring that political power cannot
oppress or enslave people.

ولا تطيعوا امر المسرفين
"And do not follow the command of
transgressors."

- Surah Ash-Shura: 151

4) Rule of Law:

Tawhid bind the ummah under one allegiance
to Allah, preventing tribalism, sectarianism, and
factional politics.

واعلموا بحبل الله جميعاً ولا تفرقوا

And hold firmly together to the rope
of Allah and do not be divided.

- Surah Al-Imran: 103

Critical Analysis: Human Liberation:

Tawhid, as the foundational creed of Islam,

functions as a transformative force that liberates the human being from every form of servitude. Critically, Tawhid liberation is qualitatively different from secular freedoms. Modern secular ideologies claim to free human from religion but often replace God with new idols such as nationalism, fear of people, human desires, and other authority. Tawhid avoids these traps by guiding a person what true freedom means. The freedom that is grounded in moral accountability and spiritual dignity. Tawhid ensures that liberation does not produce class in fact liberate a human from all forms of servitude. Secondly, Islam has a powerful belief system that elevated human creed and race from the slave, the weak, the poor, the woman, and the marginalized, because their worth is measured by Taqwa. To summarize, in essence Tawhid has multidimensional implications on human life, society, and political system of an Islamic state. Tawhid is the only concept exists that liberates human from all forms of servitude through soul purification, moral accountability, social justice, rule of law, and legitimacy of leadership.
