Man is a land animal. Land has been freely provided by nature, therefore, a man if he is to enjoy his right to live, must not be impeded in the free use and enjoyment of this basic element. Air, sunshine, and water are other elements essential to his existence, freely provided by nature, and the enjoyment of these also must not be hindered by any man-made laws. To refuse to some men the right to use freely any of natural elements is to endanger their lives. The Judaic law says : "Thou shalt not kill." This implies the right of all men to live. Therefore, any law made by man, though it may be a law enforced by Government authority, which denies to any human beings the right to use freely and fully nature's gifts, thereby endangering their lives, is breaking a basic moral law, and is indeed designated by many of the most profound religious and philosophic thinkers as "the original sin which gave rise to social injustice."
