⇒ Importance Of Education In Quran:

Emphasis In Constitution Of Pakistan:

The importance of education can also be realized from the "Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan - 1973" which states in Article - 25(A) that, State must provide education to young of age six to adults.

=> Practical Steps Taken By Prophet (P.B.U.H)

① In Early Madina - Focus on Poetry:

Before prophet (P.B.U.H) migration to Medina, the Medinite educational institutions, focused solely on teaching poetry and literary texts.

② Mosques - also a hub of learning:

③ Transformation of Mosques into Schools:

After Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) arrival to Medina. He transformed Mosques into schools, means mosques were used for prayers as well as a hub of learning.

Holy Prophet build first mosque, "Masjid-e-Quba", after migrating to

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Medina. Which was also used as a school. After that "Suburb of Medina" was also established for prayers as well as learning.

③ First Islamic University:

The terrace of Masjid-e-Nabvi - which is known as Saffa in Arabic. About 80 companions used to study and learn over there. Prophet (P.B.U.H) used to come daily and teaching them. This place was known as "Al-Suffa". Those companions after achieving immense knowledge were sent to different places of Medina and worldwide to impart knowledge.

④ Syllabi:

The main purpose of teaching was to make the students understand the meaning of Quran and its implied meanings. Secondly the aim was to transform or mould the character of human beings. Third, to teach them Arabic language. Fourth, the main focus was on

5 Acquiring Foreign languages:

Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) also focuses on learning foreign languages. So, that it would be easy for Prophet (P.B.U.H) and companions to impart and deliver teachings of Islam to other parts of the world.

=> Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) method of Teaching:

① Probing Pondering:

Prophet (P.B.U.H) used to polish the probing faculties of companions to focus on metaphysical subjects. He said:

Pondering for a moment is better than divine services, than prayer of whole night. Hadith

② Use of Gestures

Prophet (P.B.U.H) used to teach by using gestures. One example is that, "Once he was demonstrating the dread

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of doomsday. He closed his fists and then opened it with full force that even his body swayed and pulpit shook.

This shows that he gives importance to using gestures while explaining material.

③ Wisdom

The Prophet (P.B.U.H) focuses on acquiring wisdom along with seeking knowledge.

④ Seeking useful knowledge:

Prophet (P.B.U.H) always enforces seeking useful and meaning knowledge not like early Arabs who were into learning poetry and literary works.
