Mental slavery is more chronic than physical slavery. Pakistan as a part of sub-continent remained in colonial system for almost 90 years. Colonial mentality has a strong roots, embedded in the Pakistani Nation. Country's progress is highly dependant on the Nation's perspectives and ideology. Therefore, the colonial mentality of Pakistani Nation is continuously impeding the country's progress from the very start to till the day. In every field and sector of Pakistan there are traces of colonialism of west that left the impacts on minds. From political system to economical structure every other area is highly influenced by west. Later on, the systems and policies of other sectors shows, how they are influenced and effecting the Pakistan's progress. Along with, the few way outs to speed up the progress and change the colonial mentality.

British Colonies in the history, and the current Block system of US is the perfect example of colonialism. In colonialism,

It leads mistrust between provinces, as the seats and representation of each province is not on equality in the National Assembly.

Pakistan as a representative of multiple ethnicities should have a specialized framework of political system. In country

the largest province have the lowest population and less representation in the National Assembly leads to inequality. Provincial resources are not equally distributed among all the provinces ignites the ethnic and provincial clashes. Alongside the unfair policies fuels the ideological differences between provinces. The threat to National Security and the one of the major hindrance in the country's Progress.

Economic dependence on the west, one of the leading hurdle in the progress of the country. Due to weak economic policies, the dependence on the capitalist west increases day by day. The series of loans and aid from the west makes the country a slave with no personal motives and interest. As the conditions of the institutions like IMF and World Bank for a country mostly like a web. But, you have to follow their requirement and conditions as a debt collector.

In the end, economic dependence leads to full dependence on the capitalist country.

Solving these should lowers the internal threats to the country progress. Other way, is to the direct elections for the Prime Minister would be favoured. Judiciary should be self rely not on the political powers. It ensures the equal justice for all and the healthy society. The healthy minds should be used in better ways for the country. Economic policies should be regulated to low down the debt trap and be self-reliance more, as Pakistan is a resource rich country.

In Addition to above, to tackle the impacts in social, technical sectors the proper awareness programs should be launched. The entrepreneurship should be encouraged. Government should allocate special funds for these trainings and loans.
