## Comprehension

Q1: Why does the doctrine of power set by neo-imperial America deny space to counselling?

Ans: The doctrine of power set by neo-imperial America denies space to counselling because the declaration of war against Iraq resulted in division among countries in the United Nations. Instead of engaging in debate, the American government declared war and expressed its resentment.

Q2: What is the essence of 'moral equivalence' whereas war has no moral justification?

Ans: The essence of 'moral equivalence' is that America considers its security superior to other nations. It does not care about others' judgement. War cannot be justified but America claims a special moral position to legitimize its actions.
