Title : Discipline over Affection

Modern educationalists emphasizes not to interfere with children but ignores the joy of enjoying their children. Genuine interest in children should arise from spontaneous affection, not from personal gain. Teachers with such affection can discipline without harming children's freedom. However overworked teachers usually lose this natural liking, as constant exposure and fatigue lead to irritation. Teachers spend two-hours with children, and prolonged the association with children diminishes patience. Effective guidance cannot come from strict rules or theories but from self-control and friendliness. Rules are often unnecessary when children sense they are liked as affection. No regulation can replace tact, kindness and genuine liking in shaping children's behavior.
