1. Restoration of Unity

Muslims have to encourage Zakat, Sadaqah and Halal trade to ensure the fair distribution. Eliminate b/w Riba and promote Islamic banking. Allah said in Quran Surah Al-Baqarah (2:43)

3. Educational and Intellectual Renaissance
