However, in Pakistan, these challenges can be effectively addressed by taking pragmatic measures including focusing on training and capacity building, provision of sufficient resources, and eradicating corruption and ensuring transparency.

CONCEPT OF COMMUNITY

POLICING

According to US Department of Justice, community policing is defined as:

"Community policing is a philosophy that promotes organizational strategies that support the systematic use of partnerships and problem-solving techniques to address the immediate conditions that give rise to public safety issues such as crime, social disorder and fear of crime."

The vision behind this community policing is to reduce crime rates by eradicating the root causes with the help of police agencies.

It ensures law and order situation by collective efforts.

MODELS OF COMMUNITY

POLICING

- **COLLABORATIVE MODEL**
 - Officers from law enforcement agencies along with community members, cooperative and collaborate to deal with matters of policing.
- **COMMAND MODEL**
 - The community is in-charge of administering police operations via representative policing.

ENSURING PUBLIC SECURITY

Community policing ensures and enhances public security. It reduces physical violence as well as societal violence. Conflicts are resolved quickly due to collaboration of public and law enforcement agencies. Community members and police officers not only deal with underlying causes of crime but also make efforts to mitigate those issues. For instance, community policing

in karachi aims at preventing crimes by neighbourhood watch programs.

FOSTERING TRUST AND COOPERATION



ENHANCING PROBLEM-SOLVING

It encourages business community, along with other agencies to participate in resolving crime issues. It results in identification, analysis, response and evaluation of the issues faced by the people. For example, in case

of Islamabad, community policing helps in addressing issues like substance abuse through awareness and education.

CHALLENGES IN IMPLEMENTING COMMUNITY POLICING IN PAKISTAN



RESOURCES RESTRAINT

One of the main challenges is insufficient resources, resulting into lack of facilities and inadequate funding for community-based initiatives.

Moreover, training programs are frequently deemed inadequate and ineffective, limiting the police's ability to respond to the community concerns effectively.

RESISTANCE TO CHANGE

Another challenge is that police departments

are unwilling to transform their structures, cultures and operational tactics, which are essential for community policing. These traditional policing models make the transformation troublesome.

RAMPANT CORRUPTION:

Due to lack of funding and adequate facilities, police ~~as~~ officers are forced to work in terrible conditions. Due to this, they often resort to corruption. According to a survey by Transparency International, police is one of the most corrupt departments in the country, and lack of accountability, the greed of influential people as well as depressed wages are the prime reasons for corruption.

FOCUS ON TRAINING AND CAPACITY BUILDING
