3.7) Moral & Spiritual Services:

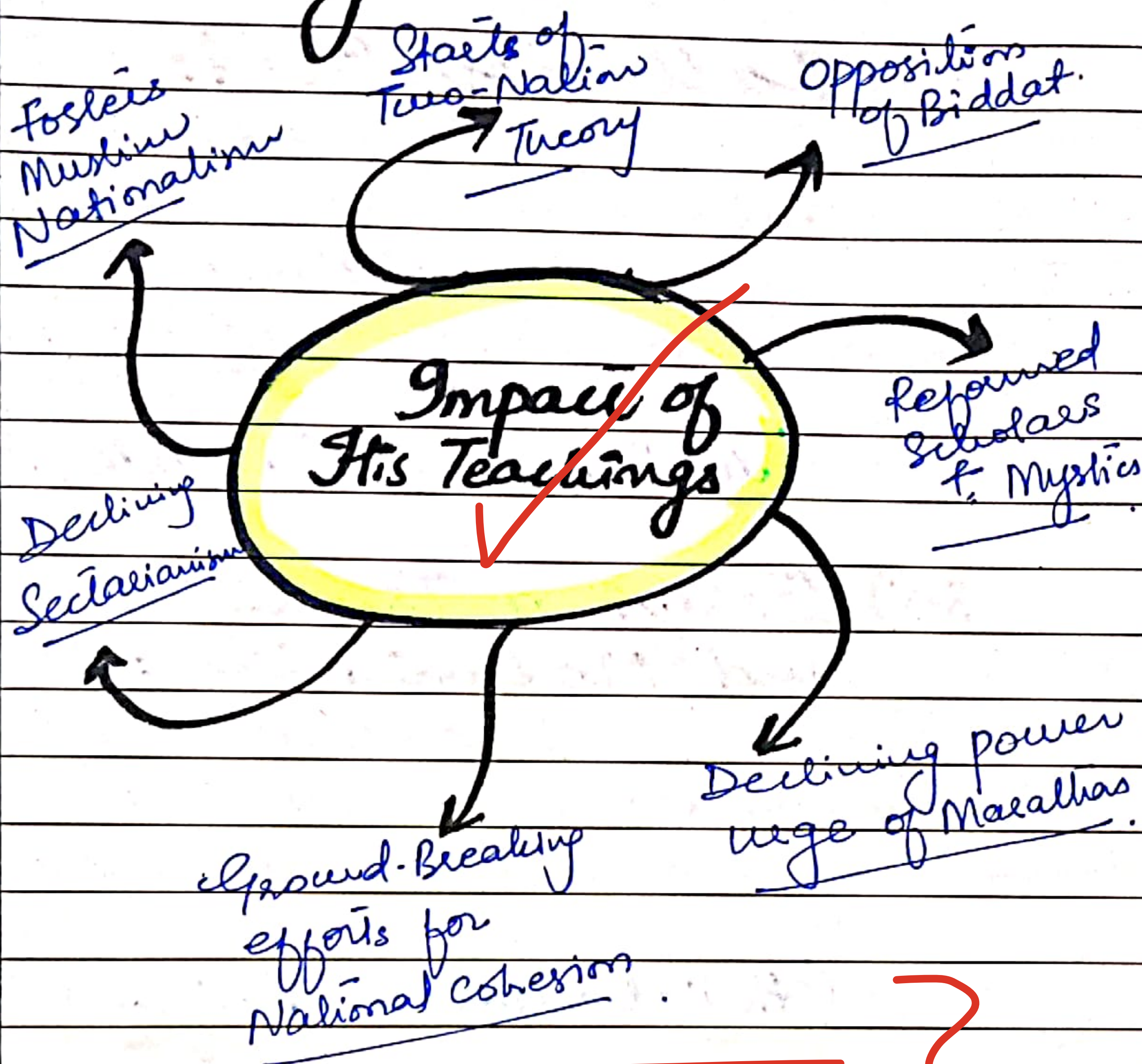
