

Q: Write a note on contemporary challenges of Muslim Ummah and their solutions.

Ans:

1) Introduction:

Muslim Ummah is facing various challenges which include both internal and external issues. Muslims have 57 states and more than 1.5 billion population. Despite huge population they have not progressed much due to multifaceted challenges. Islamophobia, economic underdevelopment, westernization etc have contributed to their decline. Joint Muslim actions should be encouraged for their economic liberalization and development.

2) Challenges Faced by Muslim Ummah:

Contemporary challenges of Muslim Ummah can be divided into

internal and external issues
which are given below:

2.1) External Issues of Muslim Ummah:

Muslim Ummah is greatly influenced by external factors which are as follows:

2.1.1) Geopolitical Risk and Religious Violence:-

Geopolitical instability creates a vacuum which leads toward religious extremism, and this religious extremism can be weaponized by external powers. It gives rise to religious violence and proxy wars which Muslim Ummah is facing now.

Case in Point: US invasion of Iraq led to rise of ISIS and US invasion in Afghanistan gave rise to Al-Qaeda which are still active in whole world.

2.1.2) Perpetuation of dependency and Dillusionment with Modern Systems:

Muslim Ummah has not used its resources properly and remained economic underdeveloped. Resultantly, it has to depend on institutions like World Bank and IMF. Their harsh policies contradict Islamic principles of self-reliance, zakat based system and Interest free finance. Further, they create a dependency cycle and countries can never get out of their trap. So, people find religion as an alternative to their frustration and it leads to unrest. These institutions' interest align with west and they remain economically underdeveloped. Case in Point: Most of Asian and African countries are in continuous debt trap.

2.1.3) Islamophobia Marginalizing Muslim Communities and Minorities:

World sees Muslims as terrorist although terrorism has nothing to do with Islam. Muslims are prone to these conspiracies and then it lead to the marginalization and oppression of Muslim communities.

UN General Secretary Antonio Guterres said:

"Islamophobia is one of the most serious form of contemporary racism."

2.1.4) Globalization - Neo-colonialism spreading western Ideologies:

Fast spreading western ideologies through new technologies and media corrupt subjugate youths minds. They become victim to these modernization tactics and forget their religion. It creates fear of future in men and women.

Maulana Maoodi in Islamic way of life said:

"Islam is not against modernization

"Westernization is an alien culture. Islam never opposed modernization; it opposes adoption of those ideas and practices which are contradicts its own ideologies."

2.1.5) Misinterpretation of Islam by Orientalists:

Islam has always been illustrated as a harmful religion by Orientalists. They had always strived to misinterpret Muslim's history and had shown their bad image. They influenced youth and presented a distorted picture of Muslims which spread expeditiously through media.

2.2) Internal Challenges of Muslim Ummah:

2.2.1) Intra-civilizational disunity and Inter-civilizational alliances:

Muslims have declined due to fragmentation brought about by alliances with other civilizations. This leads to their economic underdevelopment due to their exploitation of huge resources of oil, gas, youth). They missed these opportunities to lift Muslim Ummah and external alliances exploit them and results in internal division. Foreign factors acquire their interest and throw Ummah in wars which results in Mass migrations, economic exploitation, deaths casualties etc.

2.2.2) Lack of Research, Education and Technology:-
