### ②a Accountability as the foundation of democratic trust.

(transparent institutions ensure citizen trust and prevent democratic backsliding)

(6% global decline in adherence to rule of law, directly weakening democratic stability)

(democracies with strong audit and parliamentary oversight remain 40% more politically stable)

### ③ Erosion of Accountability and Threats to Stability.

#### ③a) Unchecked corruption and elite capture.

(over 80% of countries still have stagnant or declining corruption scores, eroding faith in democracy)

#### ③b) Populism and weakened institutions (populist regimes undermine institutional checks, causing political volatility)

#### ③c) Lack of fiscal accountability.

(misuse of public funds in weakly monitored democracies worsens debt crises and instability)

4a political unrest and protests:



(linking lack of transparency to higher risks of civil unrest and regime change in fragile democracies)

(Corruption and governance reduce GDP growth by up to 1.5% annually)

(45% of citizens in emerging democracies trust elected institutions)
