Is the second most convincing ground why the universal human equality is becoming utopic. People in Democratic Republic of Congo are dying from life-taking disease that is aggravated by extraction of cobalt that is used in batteries of Electric vehicle (EVs). Not addressing marginalised people and nations like Congo are the fundamental reason why universal human right is a utopic.

The Third reason for which universal human equality is utopic is because of political and bureaucratic unwillingness to achieve equality in the country. It is due to when humans have equal chances regardless of ethnic group, religion and class status. Political leaders and bureaucrats feel threat from the people.
