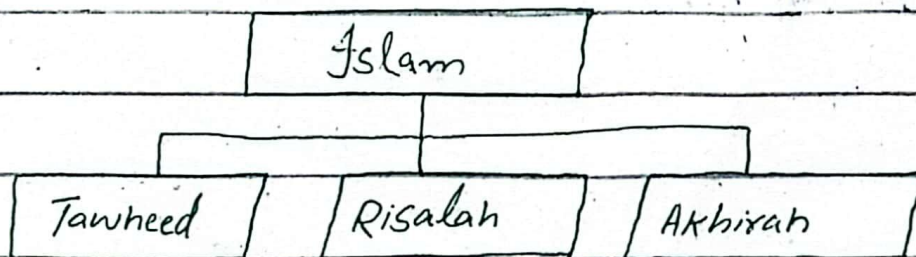
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What is The Islam?

Allah says: "He is Allah, The One." (Quran Surah Al-Ikhlâs 112:1)

2- Finality of Prophethood

Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) is The seal of prophets. "Muhammad is not the father of any man among you, but he is the messenger of Allah and seals of prophets." (Surah Al-Ahzab 33:40)
