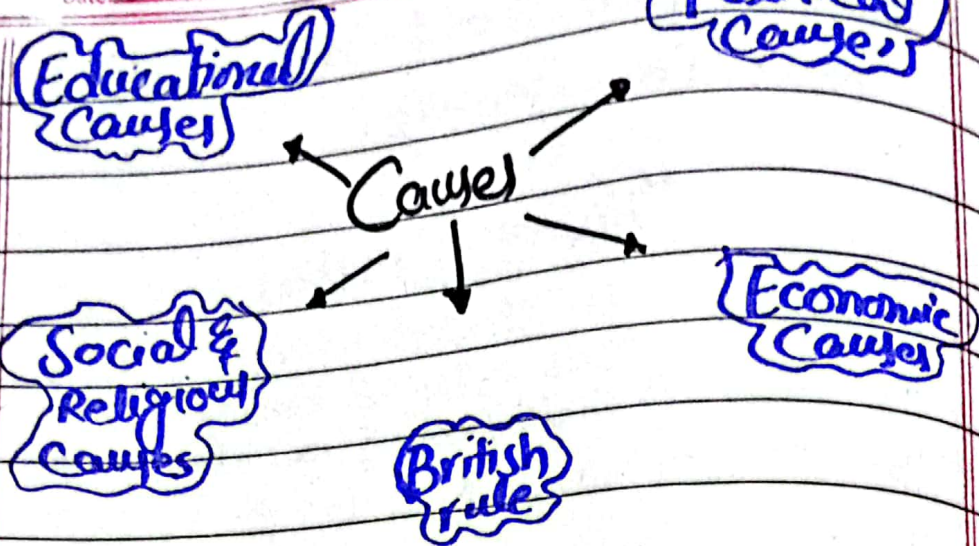

The all India muslim league was a political party founded in 1906 in Dhaka. It was a first organization of Indian muslims & played a vital role in the creation of Pakistan in 1947. It was founded to represent the interests of muslim community.

Causes leading to its formation

The formation of AIML was not an isolated event but the culmination of several socio-political, economic & cultural factors in 19th & early 20th century.



1 Political causes:

- (a) Hindu dominance in congress
- (b) Partition of Bengal agitation (Hindu protest hurt Muslims)

(2) Educational causes:

- (a) Low literacy among Muslims
- (b) Role of Sir Syed Ahmad Khan (Aligarh movement)

(3) Economic causes:

- (a) Backwardness of Muslims. (aftermath of war 1857)
- (b) Congress demands harmful to Muslims. (demands competitive exams in English)

(4) Social & Religious Causes:

- (a) Protection of Muslim identity

(5) British role

- (a) British Divide & Rule policy
- (b) Assurance to Muslims.

Formation of AIML

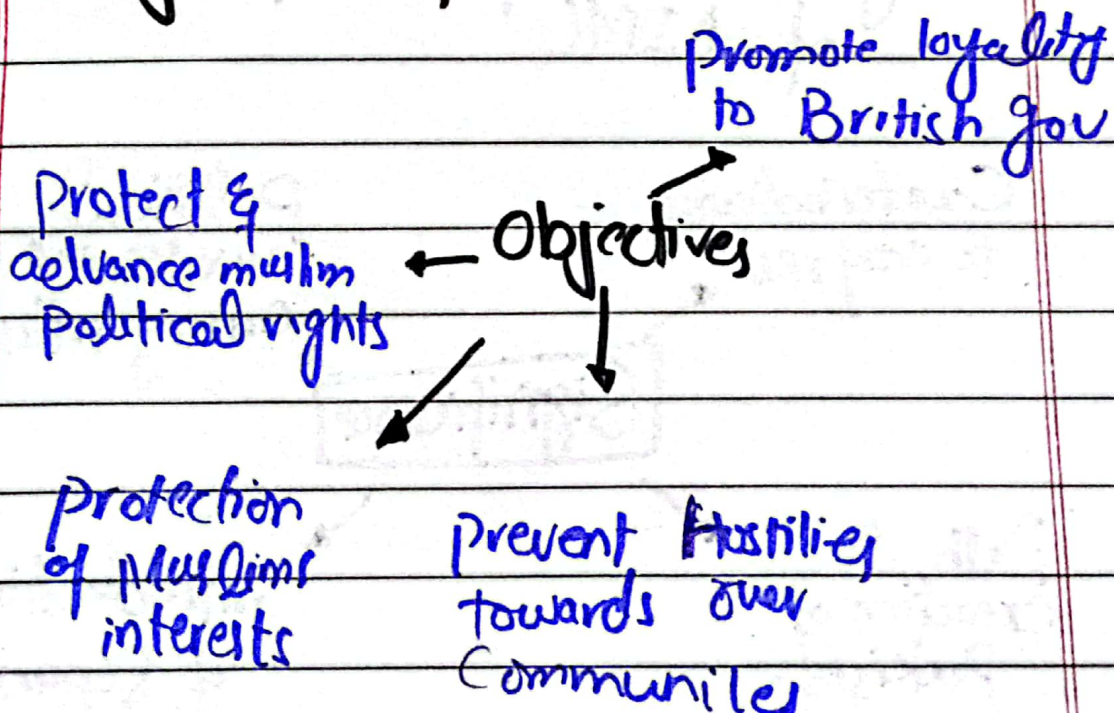
The AIML was formally established on Dec 30, 1906, during the annual session of the Muhammadan Education Conference in Dacca.

The Conference, organized by Nawab Samiullah of Dhaka, provided the venue.

It was chaired by Nawab Wajid Ali Khan.

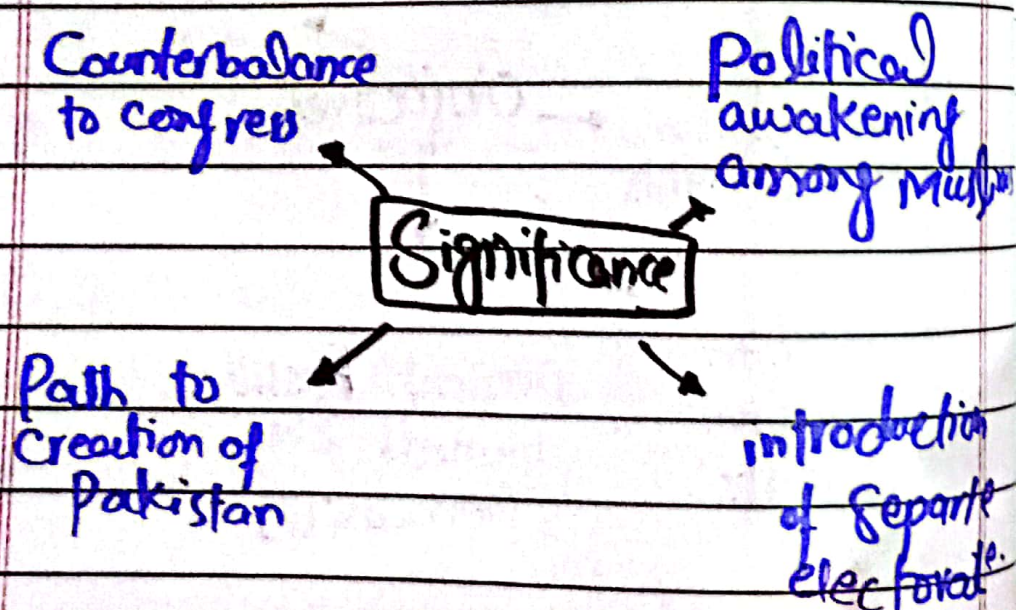
They decided in the meeting to set up an organization to be called All India Muslim League.

- (d) ^{to safeguard} always try to ensure muslims political social cultural & religious rights. •

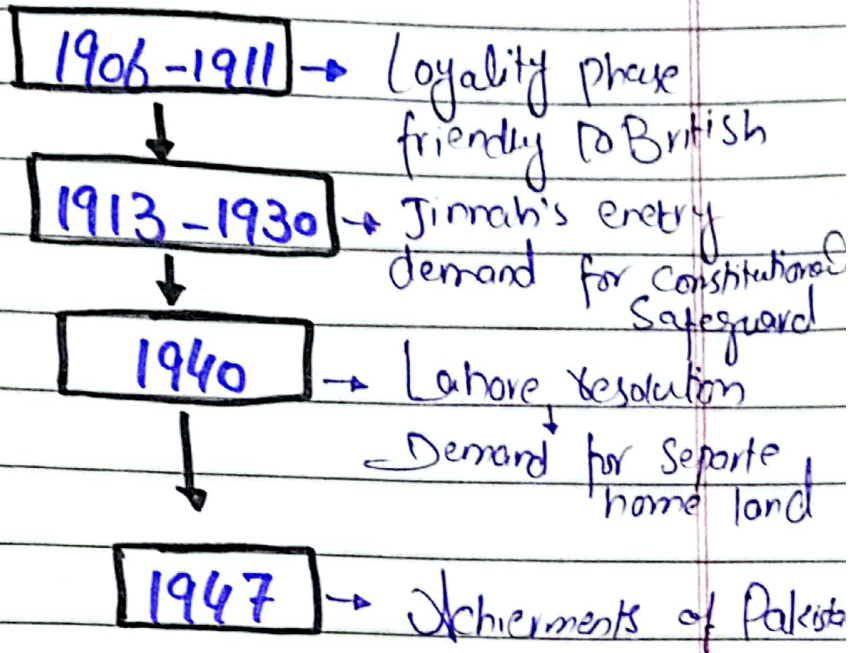
