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Karl Marx was a great philosopher. He introduced the concept Socialism and communism. In his philosophy he told, that history shaped through different stages. Changes and revolutions which ~~came~~ in history that on base of religions or Ideas but on base of resources and economy. There are few stages which are

Primitive communism, monarchy, Slavery, Feudalism, Capitalism, Socialism and Communism. According to the Karl Marx, there are two types of classes in the community, first is Bourgeoisie, is the class which hold status of ownership of Lands, Factories and industries and second class is proletariat which work under command of bourgeoisie. Bourgeoisie work in factories and industries to meet their needs. In other words, Karl Marx is discussing about class Haves which command to

The class of "Have-not". The proletariat class works under less wages and profit which comes from their work what is not given to them. Karl Marx ask to proletariat class to revolt against bourgeois class. Grab the control of state from bourgeois and abolish rights of ownership. Make transition state teach to all people equally divided resources among all people and then ~~can~~ bring ideal idealism. In ideal communism there is no concept of government, no concept of state mean stateless and governmentless community. Further Karl Marx said then divide resources among people upon the principle of "From each according to his ability, to each according his need".
