2 Difference between Deen and Religion

1) Deen:

(1) Combination of Individual and collective life:

Deen not only guides in individual life but also guides in collective life. As Holy Quran said:

Try to write Arabic too

"Man gets what he strives for." [Al-Quran]

"Live together and do not turn against one another" [Al-Quran]

(2) Complete code of life:

It is a complete code of life. As the author stated in the book "Islam at a glance":

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"Islam guides in all aspects of life i.e. individual, social, moral, material, political, economic, national and International."

3) Worship is Divine:

All worships in Islam are divine. As mentioned in Quran:

"Pay the poor rate and bow down with those who bow down" [Al-Quran]

4) Religious practices are revealed by Allah:

All religious practices i.e. fasting in Ramadan and celebrating Eid are enjoined by Allah.
