Consequences of Socio-Economic Disparity

"O people! We have created you from one man and ^{one} woman". Allah Almighty has clarified in the Holy Quran that everyone is equal in the eyes of God. It means that God has created ^{broad} everyone equal but we, humans, have created inequalities among ourselves. Most of these inequalities come under the ^{broad} topic of Socio-economic disparities. They are disastrous for any Nation! This paragraph elucidates the aftermaths of socio-economic disparities in any nation.

When there is socio-economic disparity in any society, crimes will be high. Poor people do not get their due share due to monopoly of few well offs. In order to meet their daily domestic expenses, they move on path of evils. They will rob, snatch or even kill another person to earn some money. The Holy Prophet (S.A.W) has rightly said, "Poverty almost leads to disbelief."
