D. Conclusion

Decolonisation of Asian and African world completed at the end of 20th C.E. However, the demarcation of arbitrary borders and implantation of external forces in the colonised world continue to destabilise the region. Israel and its zionism agenda is also the product of Western pernicious strategy that paved way for Israel to dispatch its duty of "Whiteman's Burden", being an enduring coloniser. The response of Hamas to the protracted occupation of Israel on Palestine resulted in the unleashing of reign on terror on the Palestinian people. The ruthlessness of Israel serves as a test case for world community in multifarious ways. Firstly, the silence of international organisations on the unprecedented killings of innocent children and women underscore its sleeping conscience. Similarly, the bombardment of human infrastructure and settlements calls upon the attention of powerful nations and international leadership. Additionally, the desecration of the bodies of prisoners of war by Israeli forces

illustrate the inactivity and inefficiency of international tribunals. Moreover, the bold usage of indiscriminate weapons on human population raises questions on the presence of international standards. Furthermore, the weaponisation of starvation, siege and blockade in Gaza instills mistrust on the working of Muslim leadership and organisations. Likewise, the spread of diseases coupled with the killings of health-practitioners is a clarion call for people across the globe to take action. On top of it, the economic gains of weapon industries through Israel-Hamas war expose the compromise of humanity over profit. Last but not the least, the expansionism of war and Israel's genocide puts the morality of world community on trial. In brief, the barbarity and oppression of Israel during Hamas-Israel war combined with the criminal silence of world is a ^{real} test case for world conscience to fulfill its responsibility.

The attack of Hamas on Oct 7 in 2023 on Israel gave rise to the hostage crisis and Israel's uncontrolled aggression on the Palestinian people. Entire world community including the Muslim world

condemned the attack of Hamas and also proposed the long-lasting solution to the Israel-Palestine conflict. Nevertheless, Israel found it a blessing in disguise to wage its sweeping operation against the Arab population of Gaza and fulfill its vision of Greater Israel. So far, Israel has killed more than sixty-thousand people who have nothing to do with Hamas. The United Nations and other Human Rights Watchdogs are doing nothing except for empty talks and meaningless criticism over the live genocide of people. **The Report of Amnesty International depicts the gruesome picture of 90% of civilian casualties by Israeli bombardment.** Therefore, Hamas's attack on Israel set stage for the performance of Israel's well-prepared script for a genocide.

Israel-Hamas war is a test case for world conscience owing to the brutality of Israel in massacring the innocent children and women. Many international organisations provide protection to women and children in the conflict zones. However, the leeway provided by international leadership to Israel

in terms of targeting the civilian population undermines the principles of international law. Similarly, the rape and assault of Palestinian women by Israeli Defense Force doubt the authenticity of international norms and councils.

Case in View is the silence of United Nations Security Council over the deaths of thousands of helpless Palestinians. Despite its power to call for ceasefire, it has become a passive spectator of Israel's evil actions against the civilians. Hence, Israel-Hamas war is a hard test case for the conscience of international organisations to turn their tall promises into reality.

Similarly, the rampant bombardment on human infrastructure and refugee camps is another test case for world conscience. As per international norms, civilian buildings, hospitals, universities and religious centres are strictly forbidden to be targeted during an arm conflict. Contrastingly, Israel is bombing all the civilian infrastructure without impunity. It has invented a flimsy pretext of targeting Hamas fighters residing in them. Nevertheless, the reality

is altogether opposite to it as the international groups working in Palestine have denied this justification of Israel. Many mosques, churches, schools, hospitals and even refugee centres have been razed to the ground by Israeli bombing despite the clear violation of international norms by Israel. The powerful nations including the United States and European Union have not imposed sanctions and embargo on Israel. The report published by Aljazeera on the war crimes of Israel paint a horrible picture of total collapse of Palestinian infrastructure with the collusion of United States. Clearly, the precarious destruction by Israel is a testing ground for global leadership.

Moreover, the indignified treatment of the prisoners of war by Israeli forces invites uncertainty on the effectiveness of international protocols, putting them on trial. Prisoners of war have been protected under Geneva Convention. However, Israel has been mocking the structure and functioning of international humanitarian law^{by} contravening them openly. The captured people of Palestine are starved, tortured, beaten and denied access to Red Cross. Alongside, they are subject to inhumane

experiments by IDF including the decapitation and desecration of their bodies. Geneva Convention, which has been ratified by more than 150 states, has lost its effectiveness to safeguard the non-combatants and prisoners of war in Hamas-Israel conflict. Hence, the disintegration of global stability by the actions of Israel is crystal clear.

Alongside the use of indiscriminate chemical and biological weapons on the unsheltered and innocent people of Palestine elevates mistrust on humanitarian laws, providing another test case for world conscience.

Israel has used more artillery and bombs on the Gaza population than the combined sum used by allies in World War II. Israel has targeted the area with advanced robotic and drone missiles. Children and women are deliberately shot as an act of genocide. Surprisingly, the world community justifies the bombardment in the name of Israel's right to defend. Case in view is the use of White Phosphorous, a lethal chemical; Dumb Bombs, dropped directionless and Bunker Busters, crippling the concrete buildings. In short, Israel is conducting a test

of his sophisticated weaponry on Palestinian population along with estimating the potential of world community.

Furthermore, leveraging the starvation, hunger and blockade as weapons of war tests the nerves of Muslim leadership. The situation in Gaza demands more than just solidarity and rhetorical diplomacy. It requires the pressure by Muslim countries to force Israel for a ceasefire and two-state solution. Muslim leadership can opt to put economic and diplomatic boycott with Israel and West to bring an endurable peace in the lives of Palestinian people. However, the cries of children dying from malnutrition and grief of mothers on the starvation of their sons make little difference in an ^{indifferent} world. **Case in point** is the conduction of conference by Organization of Islamic countries on Palestine, culminating in inefficacious resolutions and hollow condemnation of Israel's war crimes. Meanwhile, hundreds are starved to death by Israeli forces in the occupied territory, whereas OIC responds by mere posturing.

Additionally, the spread of deadly infections and

diseases in the people of Palestine, owing to the inadequacy of medicines and poor sanitation conditions, is a reminder for world community to act. Israel has besieged the Gaza strip and blocked the passage of medicines into the Palestine. As a result, those spared from Israeli bombs lose their lives by infections. Moreover, polio virus has spread in a spiralling number in the Palestinian population. Lack of hospitals, vaccination and pharmaceutical drugs upsticks the scale and intensity of infections. **WHO** has ^{also} reported the outbreak of skin infections and polio in the local population of Palestine by continuous war and blockade. Therefore, the silence of international community is assisting in Israel's aggression.

Likewise, ruthlessness of Israeli army in killing aid-workers, human right volunteers and reporters from Gaza is another indication of Israel's malicious actions. Usually, health professionals and other entities working in the conflict zone are internationally safeguarded personas. On contrast, Israel is breaching international law to achieve its evil ambitions. Prime minister

Netanyahu easily gets spared from scrutiny by international tribunals for hurting the non-combatants. The documentary of Al-Jazeera reflects the murder and bombardment of more than four-hundred personnel of aid-organisations and news channels by Israel. Therefore, Israel is making no distinction between unarmed aid-workers, journalists and Hamas's fighters.

Moreover, the sky-rocketing profit of munition companies is another question on the conscience of human beings. Since the start of war, the demand for ammunition production has increased manifold. Many global companies are seeing the war as an opportunity to double their gains and test their weapons on ground. Their owners are blind to the catastrophic repercussions of supplying technology and arsenal to Israel. Resultantly, humanity takes its last breaths every time when a child is inadvertently sacrificed for ^{mere} profit in Gaza. The report published by Francesca Albanese in July, 2025 exposes the complicity of 600 like companies in the war.
