1. Introduction:



Religion is the only relation to God at an individual level. It comprises of vertical relation with 'Man - God'. It is only at individual and spiritual level.

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


Religion deals with spiritual world only, it guides through dogmas, customs and rituals of that particular religion.

Islam is Deen, not a religion.


اَن دِينِيْسِ اللّٰهُمَّ -


