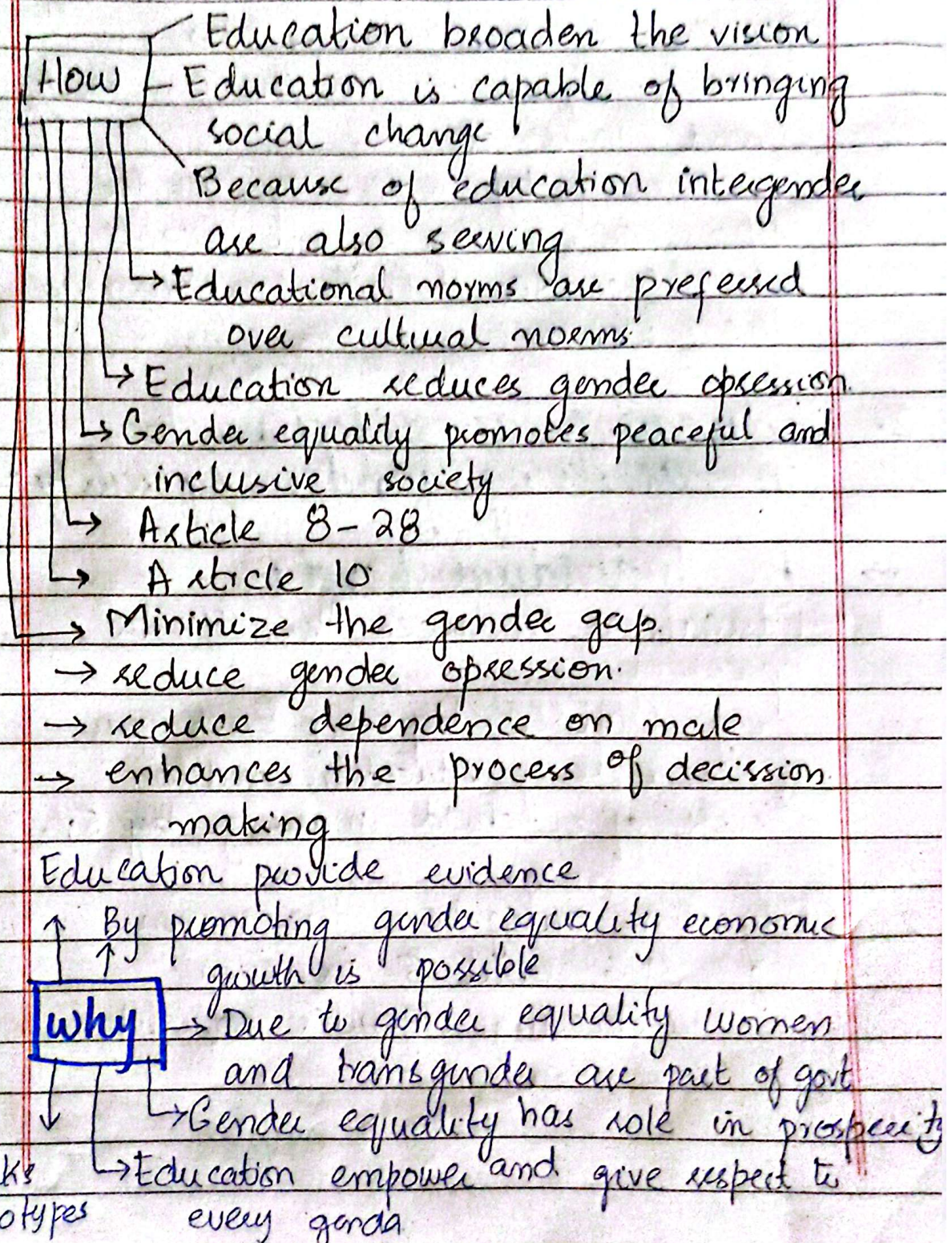

→ At Individual Level:-

1. Education reduces the gender oppression

e.g. UNESCO Report: Each year of secondary education reduces risk of child marriage by 5%.

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3- By Education, gender discrimination can be suppressed.

e.g. Article 8-28 of constitution provide Fundamental rights without gender discrimination

5- Education empowers the women and intergenderes

e.g. Personal autonomy is given by creating special skilled institutions and quota in every field

2- Education suppresses the gender gap

e.g. Women Parliamentary Caucus

3- Education dominates the role of women and transgender in decision making process.
e.g. Dr. Fahmida Mirza headed National Assembly
Sumaya Bibi → Deputy speaker of KPK Assembly

4- Education ~~in~~ ~~at~~ without gender discrimination is a source of economic prosperity.
e.g. 20-25% of women are working class from 51% of women of total population
7% of formal sectors are employed with transgenders

5- Education provide respect and freedom without gender discrimination

Article 9 guarantee life to every citizen without gender biasness
