Post-genocide Rwanda introduced peace education in schools, which significantly reduced ethnic hostility. This example is a precedent and proves that education cultivates tolerance, peace, co-existence to counter terrorism.

Poverty is a major driver of terrorism. Education reduces abject poverty and minimizes unemployment, thereby counters terrorists' tactics of incentivising violence. Poverty and lack of opportunities push back youth towards

extremist groups promising financial incentives. Education offers such incentives to masses and make them law abiding citizens. The world Bank research shows that 1% rise in literacy can reduce poverty by upto 12%. Therefore, education is needed to alleviate poverty, the main driving force towards terrorism.

Education fosters women empowerment against radicalization and terrorism. Educated women have positive influence in family, society and country which discourage extremist tendencies. Women have great influence in minds of their children and they play major role in promoting peaceful perceptions among youth if they are educated themselves.

This argument is supported by saying of Napoleon Bonaparte where he said, "Give me an educated mother, and I shall promise you the birth of a civilized, educated nation." This quote and Malala Yousaf Zai's activism proves how girls education disrupts cycles of extremism.

In addition to all above factors, education also strengthens national identity and unity. A balanced curriculum is key to inculcate patriotism and unity among citizens and it combat sectarian divides. Recently, ITP Tahrike-Taliban Pakistan is very active in online radicalization. Education is a key source to bridge sectarian and ethnic divide among citizens of any country. Schools act as practical

Educated people are able to identify and distinguish between state and non-state actors. Literate masses who are also literate in digital, cyber warfare can easily identify and

reject the non-state actors present in the country and such violent actors are funded by enemy countries and great powers for their rivalries. Education provides ground to identify and negate proxy wars. In conflict-prone areas like FATA, Balochistan, or Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, higher education levels correlate with less susceptibility to recruitment by non-state actors. Educated populations are less likely to fall for anti-state propaganda.
