A critical Analysis of Education System in Pakistan.

With information revolution, many countries like Finland, Japan and Singapore have shifted their education system from academic to technical and vocational to enhance productivity and creativity of students. But unfortunately, education system of Pakistan is still based on the outdated curriculum, text based system and untrained teachers. Pakistan is using the curriculum which has long been replaced by the world. The curriculum of science and Mathematics has long been outdated. Many new discoveries has been made which are not even included in curriculum but it also contradicts the existing curriculum. For example, in today's world artificial intelligence is prevailing, new phenomena like cloud burst, urban flooding has been introduced in climate change. But the curriculum does not even have computer as compulsory and the new topics are not still included in curriculum. Besides outdated curriculum, text based system is

also existing in Pakistan. These three systems like public, private and Cambridge based system has their own problems which also create a gap in market. Students studied in public and private schools do not have skills while Cambridge's students do not find environment of Pakistan suitable and then move to abroad. Additionally, teachers in Pakistan are not trained enough to enhance the productivity of students. Teachers are underpaid in private which demotivate them to put much effort.
