i- Weak faith and religious disinterest

(59:19)

ii- Disunity (Sectarianism and nationalism)

The Muslim Ummah is divided into different sects, ethnic groups and political factions -

Qur'an also forbids disunity among muslims -

✓ "Hold firmly to the rope of Allah all together and do not become divided." (3:103)

iii- Lack of knowledge

Ignorance in both religious knowledge and modern education leads to backwardness - And

Muslim Ummah has become ignorant in both scenarios -

✓ "Seeking knowledge is obligatory upon every Muslim"
(Hadith)

iv- Political instability and weak leadership

Many Muslim countries face instability due to corruption, injustice, and unqualified leadership. In Islam leadership is an Amanah (trust), but is often misused -

v- Poverty, Hunger and underdevelopment

Many muslim societies face poverty, hunger, and lack of development due to unequal distribution of wealth and weak economic system

vi- Moral decline and influence of Western Culture

Many Muslims are influenced by non-Islamic values, leading to loss of identity and moral decline

✓ "He who imitates a people is one of them"
(Hadith)

vii - Islamophobia and misrepresentation of Islam

Western bias often links Islam with violence, and media sometimes portrays it as radical. This leads to discrimination, hate crimes, Hijab bans, and Quran burning.

viii - Youth crisis

Muslim youth today often face confusion, identity crisis, and lack of direction due to modern pressures and weak connection to Islamic values.

Solutions according to the Quran

i - Strengthening faith - Iman and Taqwa
Muslim Ummah should build a strong relationship with Almighty Allah through Salah, Quran, and remembrance and develop sincerity in all of their actions.

"Indeed, in the remembrance of Allah do hearts find rest."

(13:28)

ii - Unity of Muslim Ummah

Muslim Ummah should avoid ^{divisions} sectarianism, and nationalism. They should always stay united on the core ~~of~~ teachings of Islam -

"The believers are like one body; if one part feels pain, the whole body reacts with sleeplessness and fever -"

(Hadith)

iii - Seeking Knowledge

Islam encourages both religious and worldly education. It promotes reflection, thinking and understanding -

"The best of you are those who learn Quran and teach it -"

(Hadith)

iv - Establishing Justice

Islam promotes fairness in governance, law, and society. It teaches us to stand firmly for justice, even against oneself -

"Indeed, Allah commands justice and excellence"

v - Economic justice (16:90)

Islam teaches us to implement Zakat system. It prohibits interest and exploitation and tells us to help the poor and needy.

"And establish prayer and give Zakat."

(2:110)

vi - Moral and ethical conduct

Muslims should maintain modesty, honesty, and good character while avoiding corruption, immorality, and injustice.

"Indeed Allah does not like corruption."

(2:205)

vii - Dawah and wisdom

Muslims should spread Islam peacefully and wisely, correcting misconceptions through clear and respectful communication.

viii - Youth guidance

Muslims should engage and

guide youth with wisdom and care and also help them build strong moral and spiritual foundations -

Example: The Prophet PBUH trained and guided young companions like ~~Ali Ibn Abi~~ Ali ibn Abi Talib from an early age.
