Ans) Origin of the word "Islam"

Literal Meaning

Islam is derived from an arabic word "S I M" which means peace, submission or surrender.

Contextual Meaning

In this context, Islam means "To enter in peace by submitting to the will of Allah" and it can also mean "Submission of all desires to the will of Allah"

Shariah Meaning

According to Shariah, Islam is meant by:

"Voluntarily entering in peace by submitting to the will of Allah"

We have to notice the addition of the word "Voluntarily" since it has been emphasised several times in the Quran, for example:

"There is no compulsion in religion"  
Surah Al-Baqra (2:256)

According to this Quranic reference, there is no force or "jābar" in Islam and all of mankind must submit to the will of Allah without any external force.

Ibne Khaldun quotes:

"Islam is the submission to the will of Allah and acceptance of His Law"

Quite simply, he has pointed out that acting according to Allah's desires and following His Law is the key to true understanding of Islam.

Prophet (S.A.W) remarks

The prophet (S.A.W) states that two key acts encompass the meaning of Islam. First is the acceptance of Allah and His Law and Prophet (S.A.W). Second is the

establishment of the five pillars of Islam.

### Scholarly renaissance

Dr Hamidullah states that

"Islam is a monotheist deen"

According to Dr Hamidullah, Islam where is meant by acceptance of one GOD (Allah) and total followance of his Law.

### Salient F

Islam is meant for all of mankind

The best and key feature of Islam is its unprecedented guidance for all human beings. It is not confined to any, specific time period, geography or ethnicity. It is unprecedented because religions before Islam were meant for following during that time period only or only people from a specific geography like India in
