

Issues OF Educational system in Pak

Argument: Low budget allocation: ^{To begin}
with, low budget allocation is one of the
major issues faced by educational system in
Pak. Budget allocation is the amount of money
specified by government for the expenditure
of different institutions. Efficient budget
allocation is necessary for the quality education
in society. In Pakistan, inadequate teaching
staff, lack of quality laboratories and over
crowded classrooms are the major indicators
which show the negligence of government
officials. In addition, worst condition of
schools building, washrooms and limited
access to clean drinking water further
exacerbate the challenges. The standard percentage
of budget allocation for education is 4%
in the world. In Pakistan has been
failed to achieved this percentage since
independence. As according to international
crisis group, Pakistan is one of the

12 countries in the world that spends less than 2% of GDP on education. Instead of increasing, this percentage is decreasing with time as according to Economic Survey of Pakistan, in 2018-19 total government spending on education is 2% which dropped to 0.8% in 2024-2025. Therefore, low budget allocation is the major reason of low quality education.
