- (i) Weaponization of Narrative
 - (a) Propoganda and disinformation.
 - (b) Echo chambers such as X (Twitter) and Tiktok
- (ii) Dehumanization
 - (a) One side faces collateral damage (Palestine)
 - (b) Other side act as a victim (Israel)

(iii) Geographical and selection bias

- (a) Western media (Pro-Israel bias): outlets like NY times and times of India.
- (b) Eastern media (Pro Palestine bias): outlets like Al-Jazeera.
- (c) Selection bias includes selective reporting and showing one side of conflict.

(iv) Communication blackouts and targetting journalists

- (a) Destruction of internet infrastructure, especially in Gaza is creating "Vacuum of information."
- (b) Palestinian journalists have faced the highest casualties rate in modern history.
85 out of 124 journalists were killed.

- (a) Limited access to platforms that were showing real-time informations.
- (b) Imposed restrictions on several platforms including the shadow ban of multiple accounts of journalists sharing Palestine's perspective.

- (b) Using words like killed vs died, attack vs retaliation - creating Verbal conflict.

3. Peaceful Journalism (Positive tool)

(i) Digital Activism

- (a) Raising awareness through social media platforms such as Instagram, Facebook
- (b) Use of different hashtags for supporting real victims of the war
- (c) Raising funds through multiple platforms for people of Gaza.

(ii) Media as a watchdog

- (a) Accountability and transparency to provide unbiased information.
- (b) Investigative journalism to move beyond surface-level reporting.
- (c) Documenting human rights and presenting real-time evidence.

(iii) Media as Humanizer

- (a) Between May and September 2025, 43% surge was seen in protests for Palestine.
