INTRODUCTION:

Finality of Prophethood and Salient Features of Prophethood

"Muhammad is not the father
of any men among you,
but He is the Messenger
of Allah and the seal of
Prophets"

(Surah Ahzab: 40)

Surah Ahzab's verse number 40 supports the evidence of the doctrine of finality of Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W) as the "seal of Prophets". Absolute finality means that there will be no prophet after Muhammad (S.A.W). Numerous verses of Holy Quran and Hadith evidenced the finality of Prophethood. Moreover, Holy Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W) was declared as "Karam-un-Nabiyeen", as there is universality of Prophethood for all the times, Prophet is worthy of obedience, annulment of Shariah has been granted to Holy Prophet (S.A.W). Furthermore, Islam as a Deen has been perfected on Prophet, and Holy Prophet's age has been declared as a

path to Ummah to follow.

2.2) Quranic Evidence of the finality of Prophethood:

Allah Almighty proclaims in Surah Araf as:

كُلُّ يَا أَيُّهَا النَّاسُ إِنِّي رَسُولٌ
لِّأَلِّهِ عَلَيْهِمْ حَسْبِيَ
"Say O Muhammad (S.A.W)!
O mankind, I am Messenger
of God to you all"

(~ Surah - Araf: 158)

Similarly, the belief in finality of Prophethood is one of the articles of faith. Without this, a man's faith is incomplete, if man do not consider Prophet (S.A.W) as last Prophet.

"There is no God except Allah, and Prophet is Allah's Prophet."



3.1) Universality And Eternal Prophethood:

Before Prophet (S.A.W) there used to be prophets for a specific nation and specific period of time, but Holy Prophet (S.A.W) is for all nations till the day of judgment. As Holy Prophet (S.A.W)

prophet after me."

(~ Holy Prophet S.A.W)

3.2) Worth of Obedience

Allah Almighty has asked His mankind
to obey Prophet (S.A.W) and follow his teachings.
Allah has asked the nation that whoever obeys
Allah should obey Prophet (S.A.W).

من يطع الرسول فقد اطاع الله

"And the one who obeys
messenger, obeys Allah"

3.3) Perfection of Deen:

Allah Almighty revealed a book called
Holy Quran as Prophet (S.A.W), and said that
He declared Islam as a religion and Deen
