
Where Dreams Come True

World's structure is anarchic (absence of world government) leading countries to pursue power for survival. Kenneth Waltz, founder of neo-realist paradigm, considers countries' desire for power and reigning is worthy ambition for survival. Similarly, the statement, "To reign is worth ambition, though in hell" highlights the importance and worthiness of reigning, lasting power, and maintenance of control even when surrounding conditions are worst (hell like conditions).

Concept of self-control which posits that conditions such as uncontrolled desires influence must not overcome the person points towards the worthiness of reigning in worst conditions.

Maintaining control and pursuit of power in hell-like conditions help achieve desired goals along with satisfaction. Leaders aim to pursue power in devastating conditions to preserve legacy of nation. Sustaining power helps achieve recognition which one desires for group. Countries, similarly, aim for stability through autonomous policymaking over influence of foreign actors. Preservation of national identity and self-hood

in extremely devastating conditions is considered worth ambition than assimilation of identity. Similar manifestations are seen when countries maintain desired world order and secure domination even when they are economically crippled. Hence, pursuit of power and maintaining control is worth ambition even in devastating and worst condition than servitude!

6) Wars remain rational choice until collateral damage knocks at homeland.

8) Economic impact is reduced through protectionism

- ▶ Smoot + Hawley Tariff Act (1930)

9) Oppressive governments survive international condemnation; however, interventions for human security leads to their collapse

- ▶ United Nations and Great powers consensus on 'Responsibility to Protect'

- ▶ International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda

10) Country remain pursuing desired goals until revolutions caused by resentment threatens its legitimacy
