

Child Labour: A Neglected Issue

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There is a Hadith that, "If you save one life you save whole humanity and if you destroy one life you destroy whole humanity". One child is one life and child labour represents their future, their whole life is

destroyed but no one cares. Child labour means using childrens for unproductive physical activities and paid them very low. Child labour issue seems as a neglected issue because policies are just in drafts and not implemented properly. And increasing number of child labour also show that no proper action taken for this issue that's why problems spreading day by day. Lack of awareness in rich that they can do more better works than just becoming a labour. One of the major problem is lack of understanding of causes of child labour that leads to this issue negligence. There are many causes like lack of parenting, financial problems,

, lack of awareness, increasing number of unemployment and lack of career counselling. If we better understand the roots of problem we can solve this efficiently.

Concept of child labour is this: Using childrens at low paid for unproductive works and not understanding that they can do better works in future if now they involve in productive activities. The issue of child labour is not in single country but spread in both developed and developing countries. Child labour not only perform physical work but also used in online tasks i, at very low wages. Their age of learning and gaining knowledge used in very cheap works and they don't even recognize their abilities due to lack of awareness. And even those who use and promote this not understand the outcomes of child labour. Thus understanding the concept of

child labour is important to address this issue

Child Labour issue seems as a neglected issue due to many reasons. Some of them are following

Policies to address this issue are just remains in drafts and documents. Properly, strict actions to implement them are not showed by authorities not allocating a proper measures or force to check and stop this issue, show that authorities not consider this issue seriously. No strict punishments for those who use and promote child labour shows that authorities support the criminals not victims. Thus by understanding this we can say that child labour is a neglected issue.

Another factor that can be used as a evidence to show that child labour is leads to negligence, is the increasing number of child labour day by day. If authorities

seriously consider this issue and take measures than child labour should be decreased but we see opposite of this. Child labour increased day by day, in unhealthy physical and also online works to meet their financial needs and to earn a appreciation from unknowledgeable persons of the society that they are doing good job, supporting family etc. But they not know unfortunately that their childrens can perform better in future if now they invest on them. Thus this increasing number of child labour can also show the negligence of this issue.

Lack of awareness in childrens due to lack of awareness campaigns also show that issue is neglected because victims are not aware enough about their skills and abilities. When victims ~~are~~ do not understand their value, their potential to do much better than

they are doing now, how they resist to do cheap works. Authorities not invest in awareness campaign shows that do not take the victims awareness seriously. If children are mature enough to understand the value of their time, their energy and their respect, and rights; the issue would be solved easily. And this can only be done by awareness campaigns.

Authorities made policies but not work because of lack understanding of major roots of the issue and then it seems that child labour is neglected issue. Some of them are following

Lack of good parenting leads to increasing number of child labour day by day. Children learn from their home more than the institutions at their age. Their goals, dreams are shaped by how their parents getting inspiration from those who earn support their family as early

as possible at young age. Parents also lose control on childrens when they always insult them at their mistakes without making them aware of how to avoid ^{some} mistakes next time. So childrens go where they ~~find~~ appreciation and financial incentives also. And in this way they start doing cheap works. Parents also not know the potential of their childrens that they can do much better if we invest on them at early age. Thus campaigns for good parenting can leads to solution of this issue because parents are the first persons who send their childrens for cheap works.

Another main factor is the lack of awareness and understanding that child labour can be turned into productive youth that can brighten the future of country. If authorities understand this they will take actions against

child labour. Authorities needs to understand this that they just need a little consideration and investment to polish the skills of child labour that make them more productive. As child labours have a potential, energy, and curiosity to learning so they can be easily and early trained for productive skills. Thus understanding this we can make policies and take actions which can solve this solution.

Financial instability in families leads childrens to become a source of income to support family. Lower income families or below the lower income families send their childrens for work and in this way they pass on poverty generation to generation. So authorities should make policies that address the financial needs of poor families and strictly command them to send their childrens for study.

Lack of job guarantee from educational institutions leads to childrens from out of school and start working at low wages. Mismatch between the curriculum and demands of skills needed in industry leads to degree as just a piece of paper that not guarantee job. So authorities needs to address this cause also by making policies to update curriculum strictly commands the universities to follow that.

Lack of awareness in those who use and promote child labour also a main cause of increasing number of child labour. If those who use and promote this, understand that childrens are same for everyone, means they are same as your own childrens, they have also deserves to get better education, to be treated respectfully,

and that they can serve better than the cheap workers. If they understand this they will not use them and promote them. So awareness campaigns for these people also needed in action to solve this issue.

Lack of career counselling also lead children to be used in child labour. Even though some children have resources like financial stability, good parenting but they can't recognize their hidden capabilities in which they perform excellent than others. They waste their time in unsuitable tasks and at the end still doing very cheap works. ~~is a~~ which is available so authorities need to address this cause also to make this issue not seemed as neglected.

In conclusion we can say that child labour is seemed as a neglected issue due to many reasons.

Like authorities make policies but strictly not implement them, lack of awareness in victims, those who use and promote child labour and lack of parenting control, unemployment, outdated curriculum which leads to unemployment and lack of career counselling; All of these factors are not addressed in policies and actions which leads to increasing number of child labour that showed that this issue is neglected. We need to make holistic approach to create and implement the policies to address this issue so that it not be consider as a neglected issue.
