


Both the countries have always stood up for each other at the international forums which is visible by how China has always stood up for the issue of Kashmir.

Cultural exchange programs by both has opened the avenue for socialization that further strengthens the relation between both the countries.




3.6) Eradicating terrorism for the smooth running of the CPEC project

3.7) Non-interference principles of the the countries driving the relation


Both the countries respect the autonomy, policy and decisions of each other, preventing
