These soothsayers interpreted various natural occurrences from lightning, ^{and} fix behavioural traits of birds and animals, along with interpretation of dreams and palmistry. However, the Gods also used to spoke directly to humans through intermediaries. These Prophets/Prophetesses,

having transcended their human essence, used to deliver ~~God's wishes~~ to the followers. Hence, the oracles were for the purpose of foreseeing future as they were directly associated with one or other Gods. The notable oracles include Oracle of Delphi linked with ~~Appollo~~, and that of Dodona associated with Zeus.

Nationalism: A Double-edged Sword

(With the unfolding of time, the ideal origins of nations wither, says Homi K. Bhabha). This signifies the intricate linkage between imagined and lived creation of national identity, just as narratives. Historical and ethnic basis of national identities render them exclusionary and rigid, thus, negating the ideals of humanism — a concept debated by various Western and Eastern intellectual traditions. Al-Ghazali emphasizes harmony between varying identities and called for promotion of local affiliations in equilibrium with universal concept of justice. He upheld the concept of inclusive citizenship and balanced particularism with universalism. In this domain, Bhabha's work allows a critical evaluation of national

identities with emphasis on shared humanity. Although the rise of nationalism has promoted parochial tendencies, it has produced mixed consequences overall. Despite the growth of egalitarian values, the urge to dominate continues to manifest itself, which has led to disillusionments with democracy. Iqbal also warned of perils associated with myopic nationalism and imperialist essence of democracy. Imperialism and domination of rich has confined the weaker nations within shackles of territorial love. Still, nationalism is a potent expression of national spirit and needs to be balanced with universal values of humanity.

Manto encouraged demeaning allegations with moral evaluation of his works. However, he kept exploring the bitter realities of life and enigmas of sex in an earthy manner, as did Freud. Apart from having unbiased view of man's fallacies, he treated vulgarity artistically. The depiction of contemporary men and women, and sombre vitality elevated him like Joyce, Lawrence and Caldwell.

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
