Homi.K. Bhabha advances the concept of nationalism ^{and humanism} by highlighting the complex cooperation between imagined, mythical and material in construction of national identity. Nations are constructed through historical happenings, shaped by ethnic and regional affiliations that becomes their identity rigid and obscure. Goethe and Rousseau emphasize on universal human experience while Al Ghazali and Ibn Rusid defend reason and compassion as bridge between culture. In addition, Al Ghazali's approach was to balancing love for one's land with justice for all citizens and offers an antidote to nationalist ideologies. However, the desire to dominate have a silent appeal often in violent forms while Allama Iqbal emphasize that democracy is only the outer crust and its essence is imperialist. Therefore, power of nationalism is unique but a more careful approach is needed to balance national pride with universal values.
