

The poor quality seeds lead to low crop yield, soil degradation and financial losses of farmers. Old seeds are more vulnerable to diseases such as rust, smut, and blight.

Developed countries provide farmers with modern hybrid seeds to maximize agricultural productivity.

A University of Agriculture Faisalabad report advises farmer to replace seeds every two years to increase crop yield. ^{The} Pakistan government imported wheat seed from America in the early 2000's; ~~but~~ ^{however,} farmers still use the outdated seed. Some Companies provide hybrid seeds; ~~but~~ ^{however,} the high cost constrained farmers from purchasing them. Outdated seeds restrict yields to 25-35 mounds, whereas hybrid seeds produce 45-60 mounds per crop. Hence, outdated seeds prevent yields from reaching their maximum productivity.
