Anatol Lieven's book "Pakistan a hard country" explores the potential challenge to discipline and unity among Pakistani soldiers. Lieven suggests that powerful moral and emotional pressure, such as clash between duty to Pakistan and obedience to commanders, could undermine their unity.
