At last, Guderian openly opposed the Hitler in his decision that led to the Guderian to left the army.

His relief from the command proved a blessing in disguise in a way that Guderian planned to transport all supporting elements of panzer forces (infantry, artillery, and engineers) in a similar way that enabled to keep ~~the~~ up with the tank core until fused with it.
