2. How Pakistan's agriculture is on decline that needs to be countered. (Crunch Para)

Agriculture remains the second largest economic sector in Pakistan, contributing approximately 25% to the GDP. Despite its critical importance to economic growth and food security, agricultural ^{productivity} ~~sector~~ remains low. Pakistan's agriculture has slightly declined from 4.40% to 4.27% and its provisional growth in important crops is decreased from 5.41 to 3.20% due to decrease in production of cotton & rice (NAC, estimates of GDP, May 2023). The agriculture decline can be countered by many ways but the action plan of Ministry of food & Research is quite effective. Under this plan provinces will work on retweaking of machinery given under National Emergency Plan (NAEP) on wheat, rice and sugarcane. It also provides subsidy mechanism to aligned with Kissan cards. (Agriculture Transformation plan, 2021)
