He argued that

There is too much regional, lingual and sectarian disunity in Pakistan. Even if US troops invade the Pakistan then Pakistani soldiers are unable to fight with them due to their interdisciplinary issues that usually cause civil war. He also mentioned the political discrimination on the basis of region as in twentieth century PPP got less votes in Punjab due to regional conflicts. He also quoted the saying of Lahori executive Ali Hassan who told him that even if he sacrifice his life for his country then no one will praise his sacrifice due to regional and sectarian conflicts. So, he concluded that Pakistanis can't lead towards a revolution like Iran due to their disunity.
