- Prophet Ibrahim (peace be upon him), Hajj was not same as of today. At time time people were advance is very field of life and worshiped superstitious things like astrology, idol worship, and wizardcraft. Ibrahim and his son Ismail built centre of Islam in Mecca - Kaaba to spread Islam but later idolaters called in it and Hajj become corrupted. After the birth of Holy Prophet (SAW), Hajj was restored by Prophet (SAW). He then describes a 5 points system of Hajj with proper and defined practices which have significant impacts on Human social moral and spiritual life. On certain occasion Holy Prophet (SAW) said:
- "Whosoever performs Hajj solely for the sake of God and, in the course



of it, obtain from sensuality and disobedience, he returns from there as immaculate as a child just born.

## Philosophy of Zakat

Islam being a religion of peace and prosperity in every practice benefited from the human kind.

### 1. Objective of Zakat

a.) Reformation and purification of self and one's ego.

By performing Hajj, Muslims self will be reformed and purified. He feels evil free just a child which did no sins.

b.) Establishment of sincere relationship with Allah.

Through Hajj Muslim will come close to Allah. They consider that they fulfilled the most important duty that their God ask them to do at least once in a life.



c) Establishment of healthy relationship with mankind.

Hajj is not just practice of a man between / for God, but it is a practice through which human learn to respect people and remain patient at huge crowd during pilgrimage.

## 2. System of Hajj

a) Virtue and Piety

It is important for each muslim that his or her intentions are pure and only for the sake of Allah. He must be not do any bad things during this Holy Journey.

b) Ihram and its condition

Second most important thing to do is to wear Ihram. Muslim must not wear any socks or shoes and can not meet to their mates in both holy journey.



c) Reciting Talbiyah  
Muslims has to recite  
Talbiyah during whole  
journey which is;

"Labbayk, Allāhumma Labbayk,  
Labbayk, Lā Sharika laka  
Labbayk, innal 'l-hamda  
wa 'n-ni'mata laka wa 'l-mulk  
lā Sharika laka."<sup>33</sup>

Which is answer of the Ibrahim call  
that is;

"O my people, I am a just of all  
those you take as gods beside God.  
I have my face onto Him who  
brought into being the heavens  
and the earth, having turned  
away from all false gods; and  
I am not of those who take  
gods beside God."

Al-An'am / 6: 79-80

at that time people did not listen him  
but today. Every Muslim has to  
answer his call by reciting Talbiyah.



#### 4. Doing Tawaf.

Seven rounds around Kaaba and then performing two rak'ats of prayer at Muqām Ibrahim which is also a solidarity to Prophet Ibrahim.

#### 5. Sa'i ~ Hagar act

Hurrying between Sa'jā and Mulkah, which is act of Hagar for the thirsty Isma'el. Muslim has to do as Hagar act liked by Allah.

#### 6. Wuquf (stay) at Mina, Maqāt and Muzdalifah.

Pilgrimage become soldiers of Allah, for 5-6 days, one night at Mina then next day to Maqāt then encamp at Muzdalifah. At the day break, way to Mina, pilgrims stoning stones at place marked where the army of Abrahā, the Christian king of Yemen, Ashābil-Jil (the people of elephants) reached to demolish Kaaba.

#### 7. Animals are sacrificed.

With the intentions to give his life to God.



8. Returning to Kaaba perform Tawaf  
offer two prayer Salat and  
remained Ashām.

By doing this, the pilgrim  
become Allah's solah and now  
he or she is ready to spread the  
true message of Islam to the  
world.

9. Back to Mina continue camp  
for 2-3 days and throw stones at  
3 pillars Jamarat.

For the remembrance to  
defeat the elephant army.

10. Return to Makkah  
perform seven Tawaf wada  
(for taking leave).

Completion of Hajj done  
as pilgrim return to Makkah  
perform Tawaf wada and  
leave for home with Allah's  
permission.

## 2. Social Impacts of Hajj

a) Hajj spread brotherhood.

Hajj is not only the practice between Allah and man but Hajj is a kind of test. In the huge crowd of people where millions of Muslims came from different parts of world for performing Hajj. It is a test of muslim to be patient and take care of brother.

#### 4. Fight for Islam



## 2. Social rights by Islam.


### a) Rights of duties of Spouses.
