i. Art of politics: Realist leader has the Art of politics. He knows well how to maintain their power.

ii. Self-preservation: The realist leader creates deference in the state to maintain their power and strength.

iii. Lack of moral behaviour: Realist leader has lack of moral behaviour. He has no concept of good and bad.

Therefore, as historically seen the behaviour and attitude of the fascist leader so they have lack of morality, they have the art of politics to how maintain their power and strength.

The German fascism and Italian fascism had some distinct characteristics but some were common which are:
