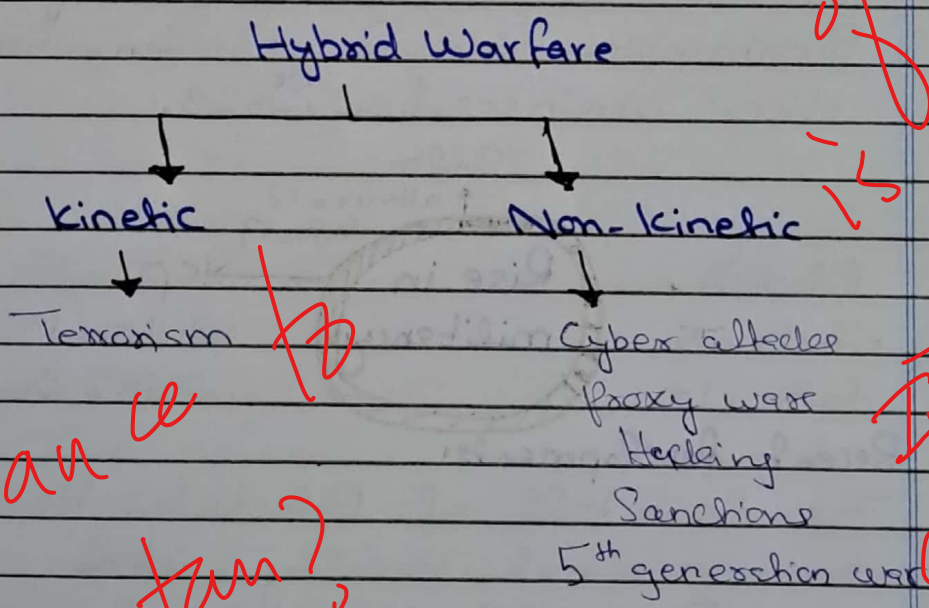

Relevance to Pakistan?

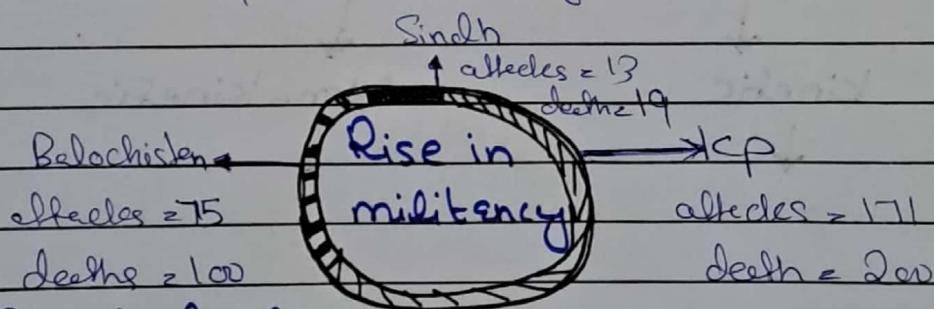

⇒ Pakistan under serious threats:

Despite serious economic, political and social unrest, Pakistan never gave up on its ~~struggle~~ ^{ability} to struggle, sustain, and survive. Out of all the threats, Non-state actors have caused great dint on national security of Pakistan.

* Surge in Terrorism:

According to Pakistan Institute of conflict and security studies, There is a combined rise in the terrorist attacks, mostly in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Balochistan, then other provinces during ^{July} 2023.



↓ Recent developments:

⇒ The death toll of Balochistan have been increased recently, ~~when~~ after Bajaur Attack on August 2023, The responsibility of which has been taken by Islamic state of Khorasan.

⇒ FC is being attacked in Peshawar, 2023, The responsibility is taken by Tehreek Jibad Pakistan.

⇒ Peshawar Police line Mosque ²⁰²² was under attack, responsibility was taken by Tehreek Taliban Pakistan.

=> Security Concerns of Pakistan:

1) Political Instability:

Pakistan being engaged to deal with multiple war fronts, has to deal with growing political instability^{on} national and international levels. For example, India has been engaged in proxy wars against Pakistan. The motive of which is to create regional hegemony; Balochi Separat are the proxy of India. That has created chaos in Balochistan by growing unrest in its security. Moreover, the result of proxy war is being Pakistan has become sidelined in world politics. Being an economically fragile state, it is in a great threat to Pakistan's diplomatic ties around the world.

2) Socio-Economic Crisis:

The outcome of hybrid warfare in Pakistan is, increased insecurity of food, water, employment opportunities and sense of political deprivation as well. According to World Bank report 2023, Pakistan has been ranked on 142 among world economies. This is followed by another report of Global Hunger Index report 2023, Pakistan ranked 99. But among all these development of negative ranking

is the report of Bureau of immigration and overseas employment, more than 8,00,000 skilled people left the country in search of employment opportunities. Thus, security issues are causing great damage to the case of ~~Pakistan's~~ Pakistan's socio-economic stability.

3) Military / Institutional weakness:

Military in case of Pakistan, is playing an important role in bringing peace and stability. In account of recent terrorist attacks, and terrorism being trained out, both police and military forces have to be on their toes to cope up with non-state actors. According to Stockholm-based Institute of Policy Research, Pakistan has spent only 3 billion US Dollars on its defence budget, 2020. This points out towards the increase in economic assets, the state has to put in, in order to tackle the militants, and halt them to cause any threat to the state. Moreover, attacks on FC and Police, ^{is to} bring about the military into the cities, ~~causing~~ causing them to relax the borders, so that violent actors, like TTP have the opportunity to occupy territories.
