In his book "Pakistan: A Hard Country", Anatol Lieven discusses how the unity and discipline of the Pakistani military could be compromised if soldiers faced strong moral and emotional pressures that clashed with their duty to defend Pakistan. He suggests that only significant external pressures, such as a US invasion without orders to retreat from the army command, could create such a situation. The perceived subservience of Pakistan to US demands has already impacted morale in the armed forces, and soldiers have expressed that they might mutiny to resist foreign invasions. Lieven notes that while regional identities might be growing in importance politically, Pakistan is a complex web of overlapping identities. He explains that various factors, including ethnicity and lineage, often prevent unity even within groups, making it difficult for a single identity or ideology to unite the country. In essence, Lieven argues that Pakistanis have diverse identities and affiliations that make it challenging for them to unite behind a revolution or any other cause.
