Concluding sentence	Hence, rapid population growth is <u>one of the many causes of unemployment in Pakistan.</u> <del>Your evidence does not support this</del>

## 20 Effect of unemployment in Pakistan

The argument is effect of unemployment in Pakistan. Not of rapid population growth.

Topic Sentence	<u>Rapid Population growth results in increased Poverty in Pakistan.</u>
Explanatory sentence	This is because a large population of unemployed people <u>limits their spending</u> , resulting in the <u>slow growth of the economy</u> . <i>What is the argument? increase in poverty or slow economic growth.</i>
Supporting Point	Public <sup>Separate Cause</sup> <u>health crisis</u> such as Covid-19 further pushes <u>unemployed people</u> near to the poverty line. Recent <u>pandemic</u> has created a grave situation in Pakistan. <i>What is the argument? Completely irrelevant. Every new sentence starts a new argument.</i>
Evidence	According to a World Bank report, <u>Poverty in Pakistan, Covid-19 may have pushed 10% of the population below the poverty line</u> (World Bank, 2021). <i>Not related to unemployment at all.</i>
Concluding sentence	Therefore, <u>unemployment due to rapid population growth results in increased poverty in Pakistan.</u> <i>That is not discussed in the paragraph.</i>

### 3% Solution of Unemployment in Pakistan

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The connection to previous paragraph has not been made in the content of given topic. For example:

Topic Sentence	Controlling population <del>will</del> not only reduce poverty rate but also addresses the issue of unemployment in Pakistan. <i>As unemployment in Pakistan has resulted in consequences such as being poverty. It is imperative to curb the root cause, by controlling population.</i>
Explanatory Sentence	This is because a large population has a direct impact on <del>unemployment</del> opportunities and economic growth in Pakistan. <i>Repetitive</i>
Supporting point	Controlling population <del>refers</del> puts reasonable number of people out in the field. This leads to increased employment. It also improves human resource quality.
Evidence	Government must act efficiently to control the population. This will <del>result</del> in increase per capita income. <i>No relation to how it will control unemployment</i> (Nayab Minhaj, Impact of Population Growth on Economy, 2021)
Concluding sentence	Therefore, controlling population is necessary to address the <del>the</del> issue of unemployment in Pakistan.
