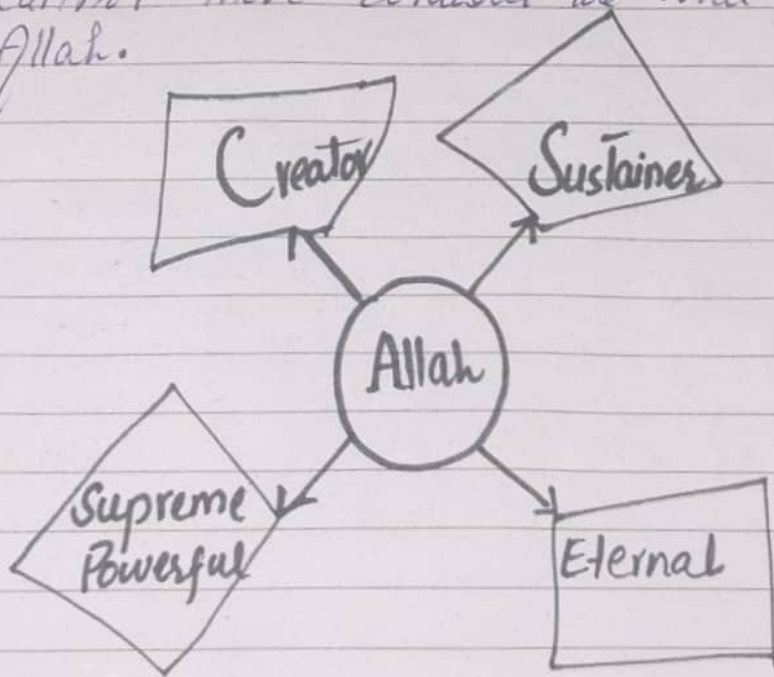


## Islamic Studies:-

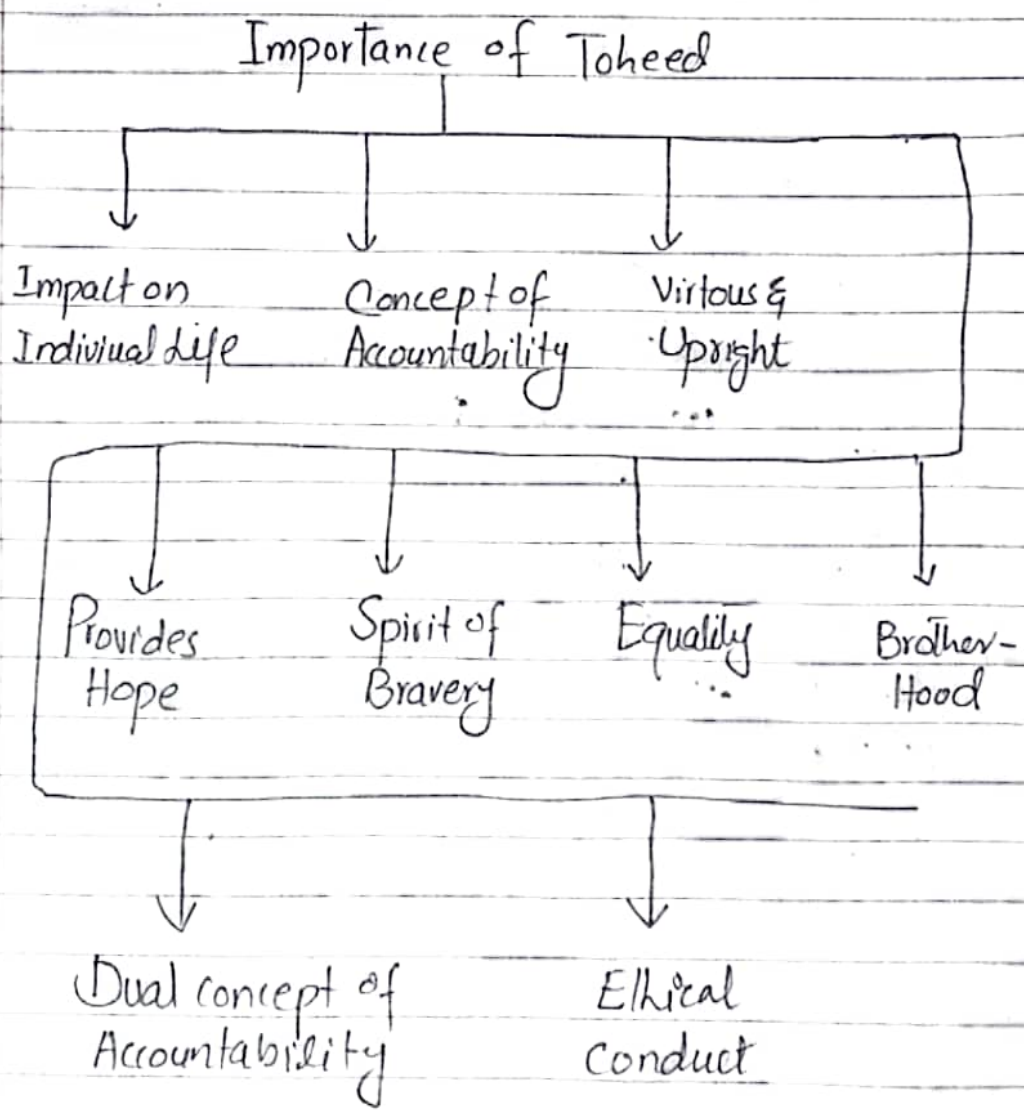

Toheed is the core pillar of Islam and first part of Kalima. Deen is incomplete without toheed.

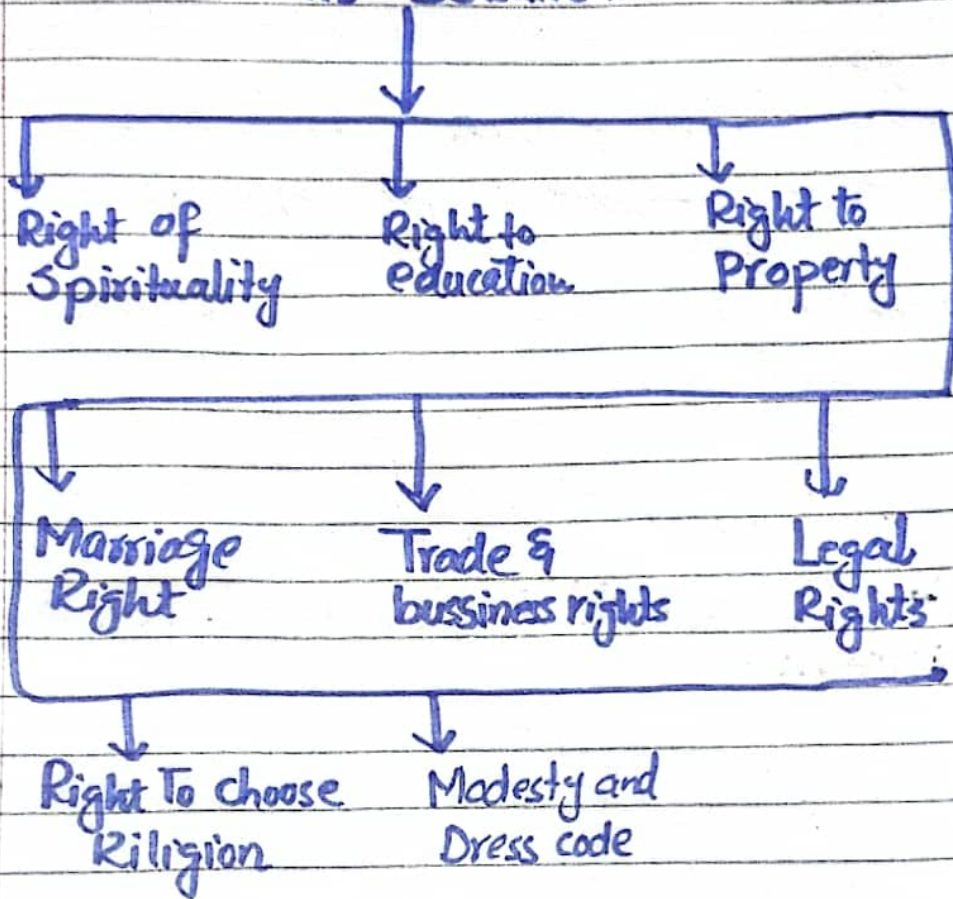

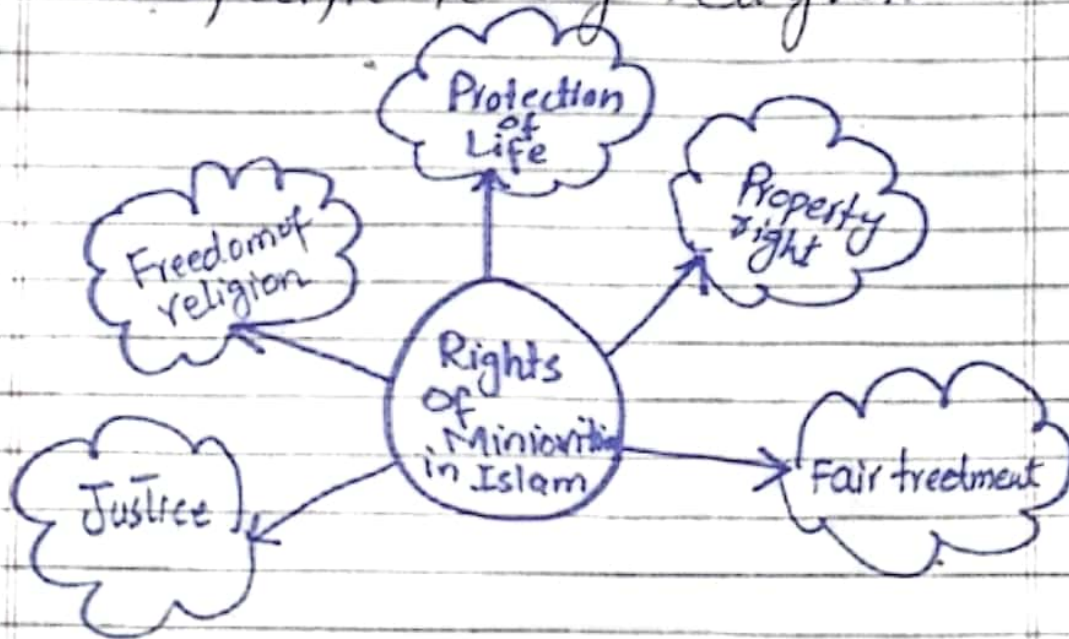




## c) Rights of Minorities in Islam:-

Islam has given direction to treat all the religions equally on the basis of humanity. Human beings are the most proud creature of the universe. They deserve fair treatment on the basis of humanity.

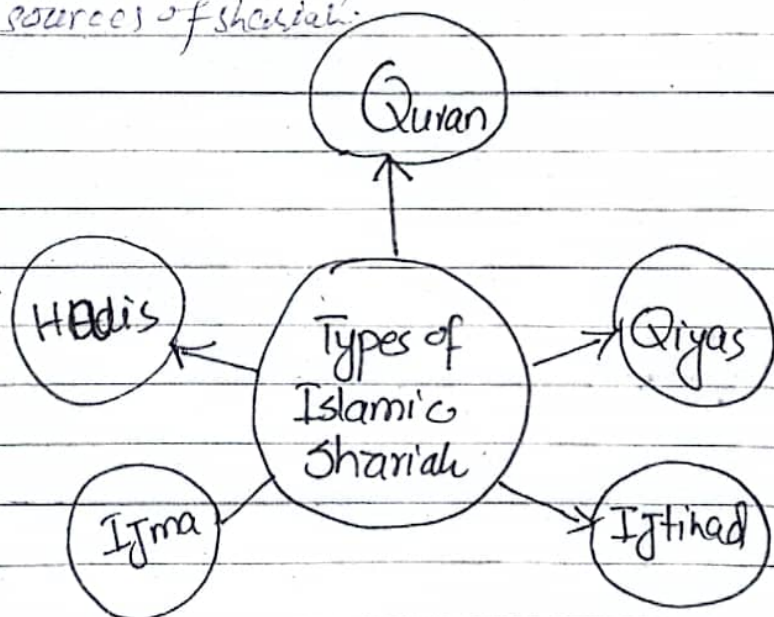
## • Conclusion:-

~~guidance~~ guidance is found in

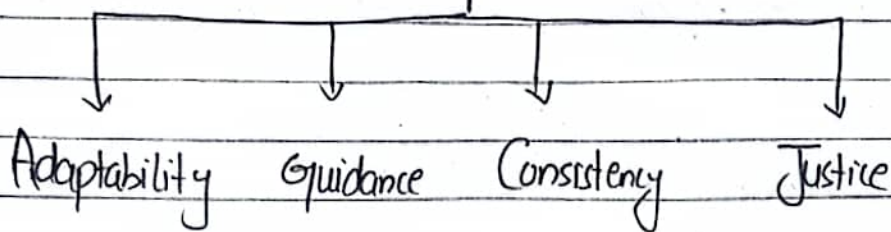
the primary sources. It allows for adaptability to new

Ijma promotes consistent unity among muslims scholars fostering a consensus on important issues and promoting a sense of community.

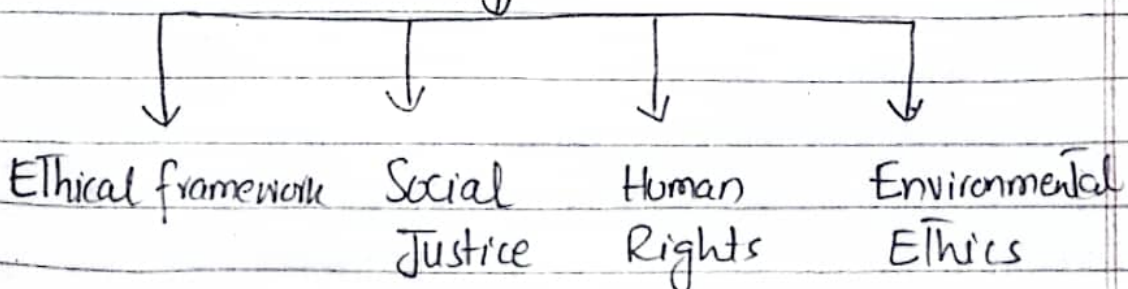
• **Justice:-**

The principles within Islamic law align with many universal human rights values, providing a basis for engaging with global human rights discourse.

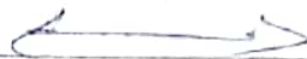
## • Environmental ethics:-

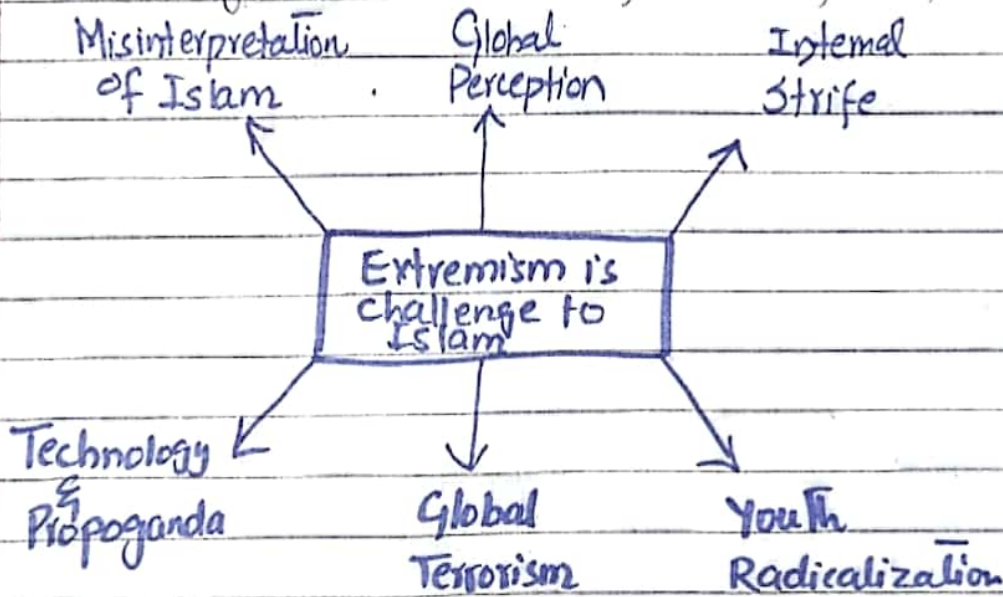
**Q.No.5:- Extremism is a challenge to Islam:-**

Some extremist groups are engaged in acts of terrorism on a global scale. This is not only threaten the security of muslim-majority country but also contribute to the global security concerns.

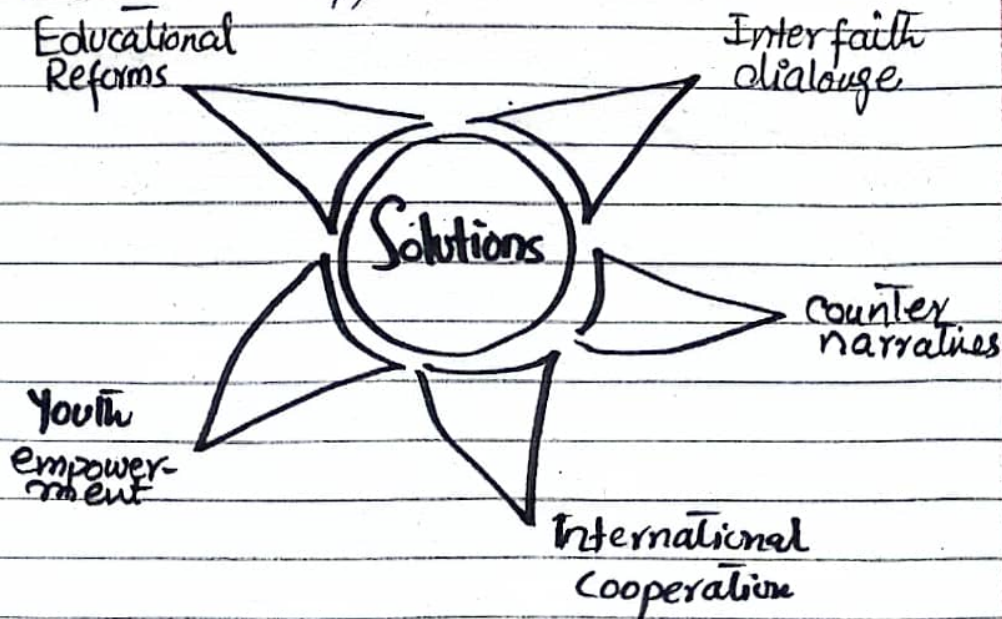
## • Youth Radicalization:-
