It is not possible to eradicate 100% crime and deviance in it. Every society has some individuals that deviates from the set customary norms and beliefs.

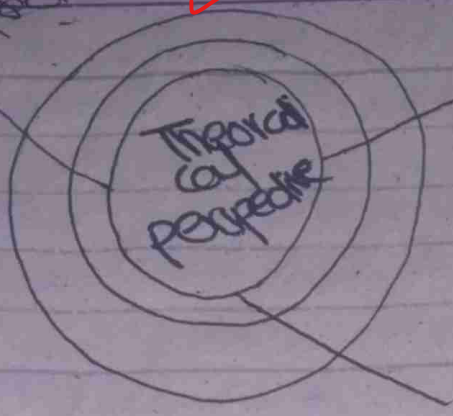
According to August Comte

c- Labelling theory:-

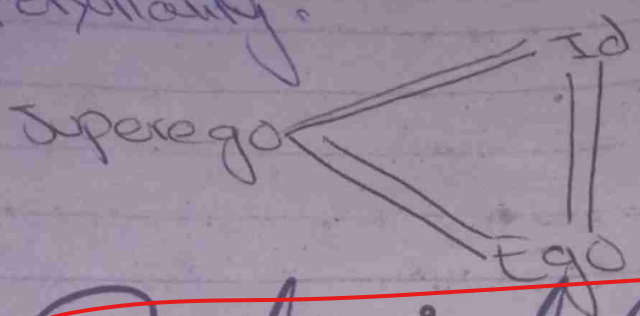

a- Psychodynamic Theory:-

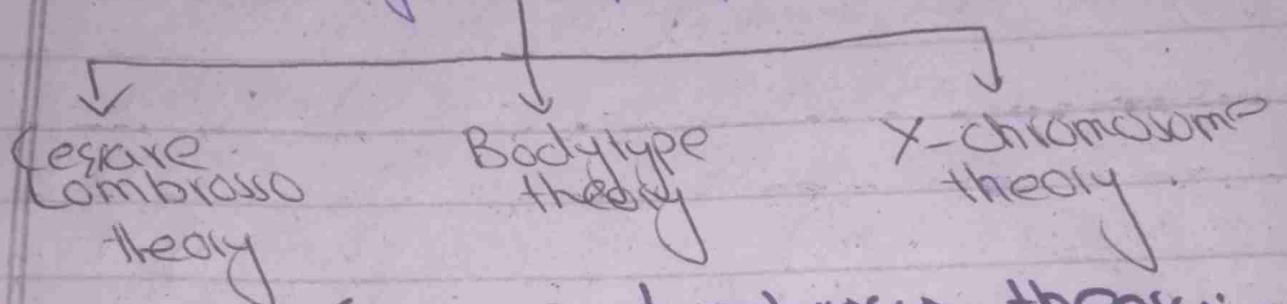
According to this theory, those individuals adopt the deviant behaviour, that have the weak superego. Or there id has

This theory links the bodytypes with deviance behaviour. Mesomorphic body type individuals are more prone towards the deviance behaviour.

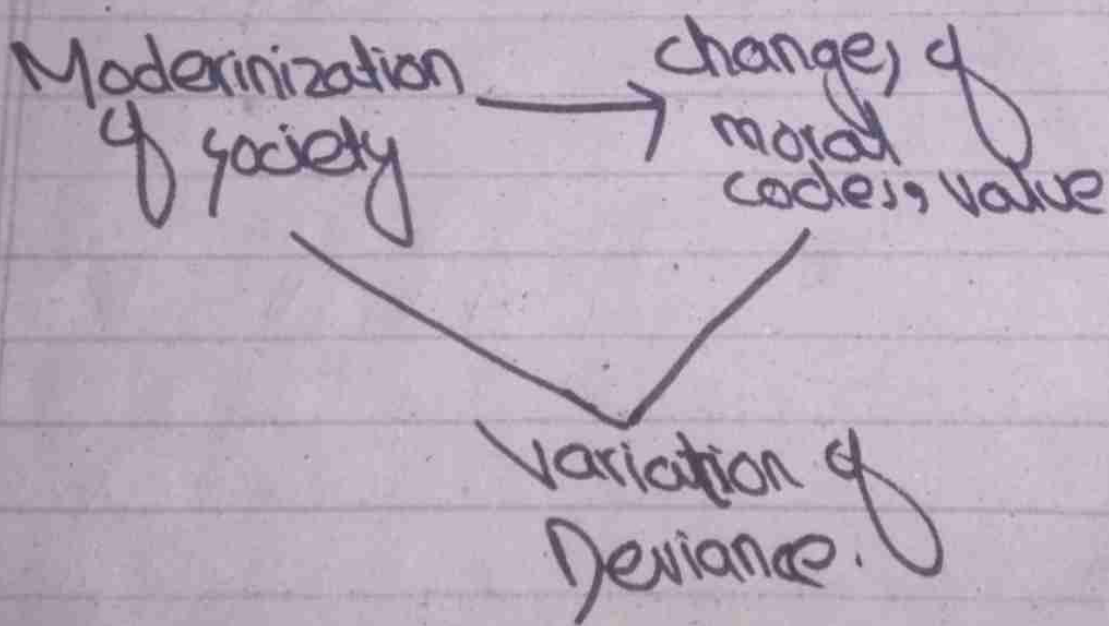
c- Y-Chromosome theory:-

- iii- Prosecutor on the behalf of the state.
- iv- Diversion for the non-trial in court.
- v- Juvenile Justice Committee for hearing case of juvenile.
- vi- Rehabilitation of juvenile.
- vii- Correctional institution and observation home construction.
- viii- Separate Juvenile courts.

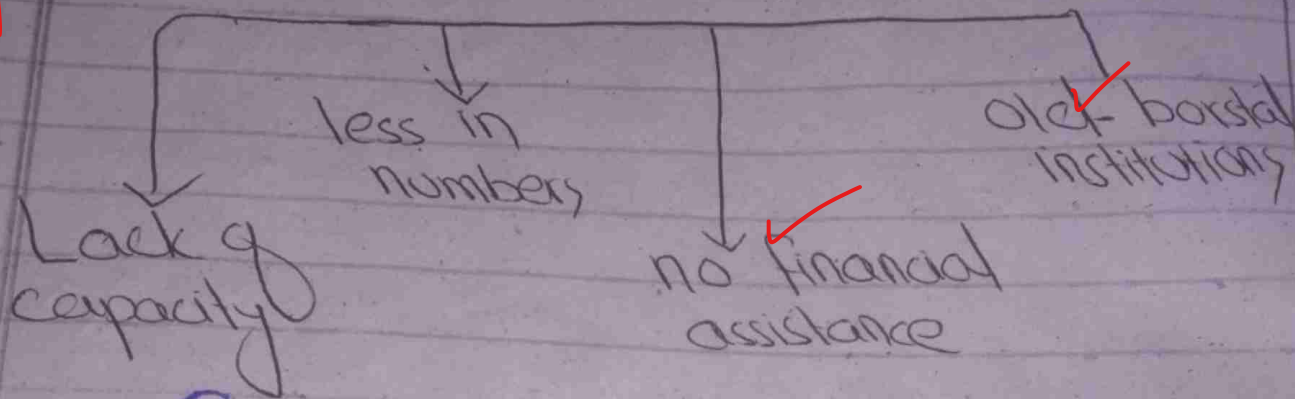

This is another reason while they are not working, or become functional now. Some of the defects in juvenile correctional institutions are:-



a- Lack of Capacity:-

Juvenile correctional institute, lack the capacity to hold the juvenile. As there is no attention paid to work on the implementation of JJSA-2018 and increase in institutional capacity. Some of the reasons due to such institutional capacity lack are:-

1- No Interest of Government

Government don't take interest in building the capacity

juvenile correctional institutions. Juvenile also still tried with adults and also are kept with adult in jails. This lead to not integration of them but further enhancement of criminal acts.

ii- Non-implementation of JJYA- 2018:-

It is clearly mentioned in JJYA- 2018, that juvenile correctional institutes has to be made on priority basis. So rights of juvenile and to transform them to be the valuable citizen of society shall be practised. But no attention is given to its implementation.

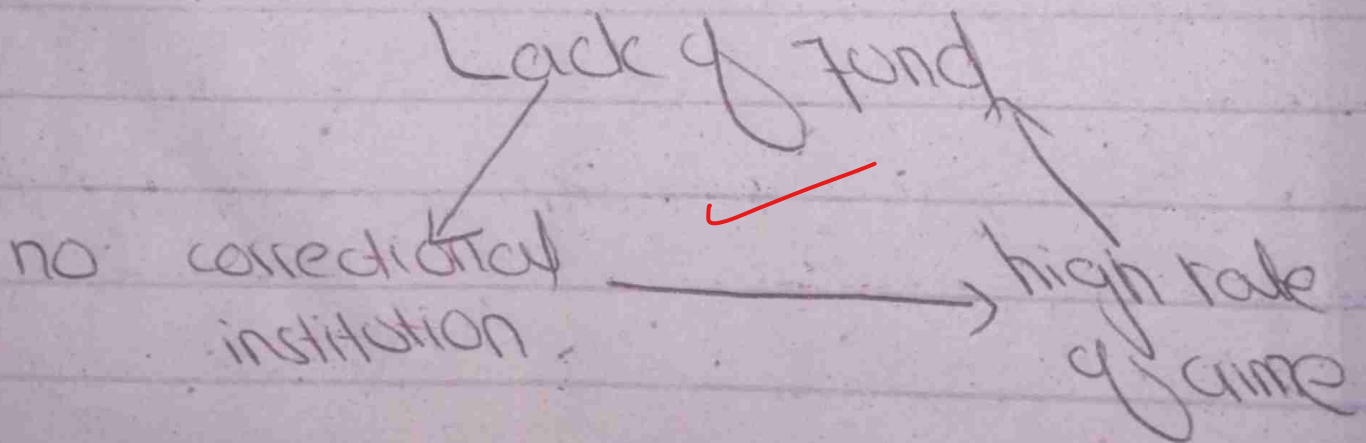
b- Lack of Financial Resources:-

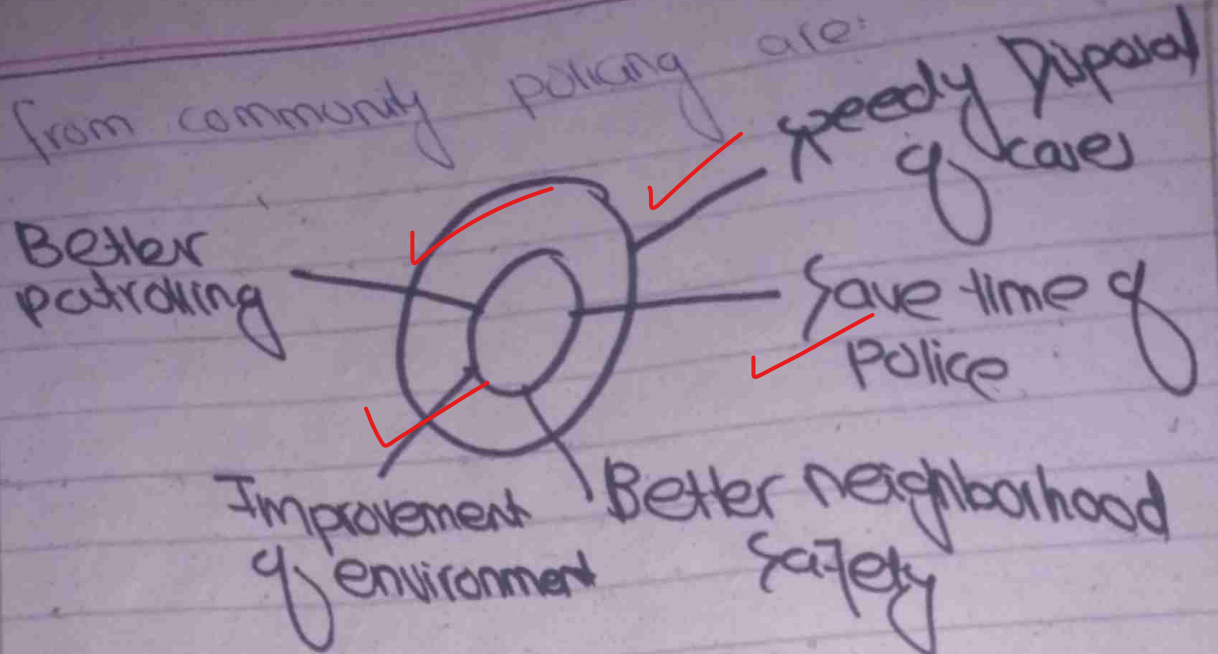

In this type of crime, the identity of the user, the credit card details can be hacked by the hacker, and then used to get the advantage.

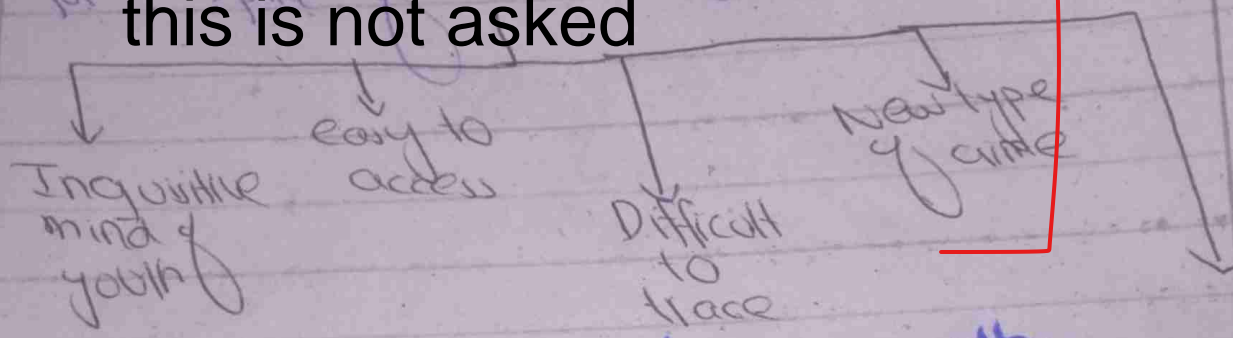
e- Unethical contents

The risk involved in cyber crime is very less as compared to the risk involved in the traditional crime. So, due to all these reasons cyber crime has increased.

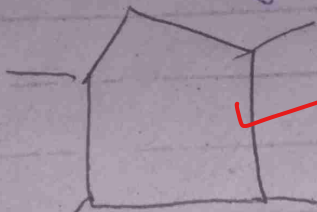
